

Remarks on Board of Ship

Thursday Feb 6th 1848

Came with fresh wind from the S.W. and thick heading East with top gallant sails out since past strong wind from the S.W. and rain took in top gallant sails and double reefed latter part more moderate S.W. with all sail out S. & S. O.

Friday 7th

Came with light air from the S.W. and thick fog steering East with all sail out since past light air and thick latter part strong wind from the S.W. and some thick heading East with all sail out S. & S. Lat 45.45 Long 133.00

Saturday 8th

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and some thick heading East since past strong from the S.W. steering E.S. latter part gentle wind from the S.W. and thick fog set the steering sails S. & S. O.

Sunday 9th

First part light wind from the Westward and thick steering E.S. with all sail out since past gentle wind from the Westward and some very latter strong wind from the S.W. and fine clear weather S. & S. Lat 45.37 Long 141.00 E

Monday 10th

Came with gentle wind from the S.W. and fine clear weather steering E.S. with all sail out since latter part gentle wind from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather steering E.S. & S. & S. O.

Long 144.40 E

Liverpool of New Bedford

Friday Feb 15th 1848

Came with gentle wind from the Westward and fine weather steering E.S. with all sail out since past strong wind from the Westward and long latter part strong wind from the S.W. and thick S. & S. Lat 46.00 to long 148.40 E.

Wednesday 16th

Came with gentle wind from the S.W. and fine weather steering E.S. with all sail out since past gentle wind and fine latter strong gale from the S.W. and heavy squalls S. & S. with all sail out

Thursday 17th

Came with strong gale from the S.W. and squally steering E.S. took in the topmast standing sail and main royal since past gale and squally latter more moderate set the standing sails and main royal S. & S. Lat 41.50 Long 165.00 E

Friday 18th

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and squally steering E.S. with all sail out since latter part strong Gale arrived and in the fore topmast and lower standing sail hoisted S. & S. Lat 40.04 Long 69.50

Saturday 19th

Came with strong Gale from the S.W. and some squally steering N.E. with all sail out to 0 in the main royal and lower standing sail since latter part more moderate S. & S. Lat 38.25 Long 63.20
