

Remarks on Board Ship

Saturday March 11th 1848

Came with light wind from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather during the day. Mid. & latter part strong wind from the East and some squally during the night. Lat 33.25 Long 117.40 E

Sunday 12th

First part strong wind from the Eastward and some cloudy during the night. Mid. & latter part strong wind and squalls of rain. Lat 30.24 Long 117.30 E

Monday 13th

Came with strong wind from East and fine pleasant weather heading S.W. by the wind and latter part strong wind and squally heading S.W. took in top gallant sails. Lat 28.35 Long 118.20

Tuesday 14th

Came with strong wind from the Eastward and squally heading S.W. Mid. & latter part strong wind and squally double reefed the top sails heading S.W. at 10 A.M. Left off during S.W. Lat 27.02 Long 118.50 E

Wednesday 15th

First part strong wind from East and squally with rain during S.W. under double reef. Mid. & strong gale and squally. Lat 23.35

Thursday 16th

Came with strong gale from the E.S.E. and cloudy during S.W. took in the fore and main top sails and cast reefed the main. Mid. part moderate with fresh rain. Latter part light wind from the S.W. and some squally heading S.W. Lat 22.30 Long 119.50 E

Friday March 17th 1848

Came with gentle wind from the S.W. and squally heading S.W. Mid. part light air and ship to the Eastward. Latter part light air from the North and fine pleasant heading S.W. about the fore top sail and bent an other. Lat 22.07 Long 119.00 E

Saturday 18th

First part light air from the North and fine pleasant weather heading S.W. Mid. part light air latter part calm and clear employed in repairing sails and bent the main top sail and bent an other. Lat 21.40 Long 119.30 E

Sunday 19th

Came with light air from the South and rainy during S.W. Mid. & latter part light air and fine pleasant weather. Lat 20.55 Long 119.35

Monday 20th

Came with light air from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather during S.W. with all sail out. Mid. & latter part light air and fine weather employed in mending sails. Lat 20.10 Long 119.50

Tuesday 21st

Came with light air and fine pleasant from South during S.W. with all sail out. Mid. & latter part strong wind and fine weather at daylight saw the westmost part of Sugar Baring S.W. Lat 6 Lige off it. Lat 17.30 Long 119.30 E

Wednesday 22nd

First part strong wind from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather during S.W. with all sail out past the Sugar. Mid. gentle wind from the S.W. latter light air and squally weather employed in mending sails. Lat 15.10 Long 119.35
