

Remarks On Board Ship Liverpool

Monday April 5th 1848

Came with strong wind from the N.W. and squally at 4 p.m. took in top gallant sails at 6 double reefed the top sails heading S.W. Mid fast heavy squalls with rain took in the top sail and main sail and hauled up the fore sail were Ship to the South. Little strong gale at 8 went to the South and set the fore sail and fore and mizen top sails at 10 p.m. heavy squalls took in the top sails and fore sail to 5/8 fresh rain No Ch.

Tuesday 6th

Came with fresh gale from N.W. and a fresh rain at 4 p.m. set the fore sail heading to the South. Mid fast strong gale and fresh rain were Ship to the South. Little part more moderate were Ship to the South set the fore sail at 10 p.m. set the fore and mizen top sail least reefed No Ch.

Lat 3° 30' Long 175 30

Wednesday 7th

First part strong wind from the N.W. and squally set the main sail and jib took out the reef out of the top sails heading S.W. at 6 heavy squalls with rain clear reefed the top sails took in the main sail and jib down Ship to the S.W. Mid fast strong wind at 10 p.m. had a very heavy squall from N.W. with fresh rain. Little part more moderate were Ship to the S.W. at 1 p.m. saw "Pascall" Island very low bearing S.E. set about 6 or twelve miles Ship heading N.E. with all sail out at 12 were Ship to the Westward S.S.

Thursday April 5th 1848

Came with strong wind from the South and some cloudy heading S.W. with all sail out at 10 took in top gallant sails and jib and main sail at 11 had squalls from the S.E. and fresh rain double reefed the top sails. Little light air from the S.W. and cloudy sunset with sail set Lat 3° 00' Long 175 00

Friday 6th

Came with light air from the N.W. and some cloudy. Strong S.W. Mid fast gentle wind and fine weather. Little much the same Lat 3° 30' Long 175 30 E.

Saturday 8th

First part gentle wind from the N.E. and fine weather. Middle part strong S.W. Mid 5/8 part light wind and fine weather S.S. Lat 2° 37' Long 175 30

Sunday 9th

Came with light air from the S.W. and some cloudy at 4 p.m. took Ship to the S.W. at 9 p.m. took to the Westward. Mid fast light air and fine weather at 10 p.m. took Ship to the S.E. S.S. Lat 2° 49' Long 172 05 E.

Monday 10th

Came with light air from the N.W. and fine weather heading N.W. Mid 5/8 part light air Ship on different tracks S.S. Lat 2° 30' Long 174 30 E.
