Sunday April 21st 1848

Came with light air from the S.E. and
gaily with rain steering West by compass
Mid part light air and pleasant latter calm
a small Island on side called Hunters
Island 10 miles off it is laid down 15 miles to
far to the distance ^{on} the chart

Monday 22nd

First part light wind from the South and
squally steering West Mid part much the same
latter part light air from the Eastward and fine
weather steering N.W. with all sail out

Lat 6.09 Long 168.05

Tuesday 23rd

First part light air from the Eastward
and pleasant steering N.W. Mid part better
first gentle wind and some squally with rain
latter with all sail out

Wednesday 24th

Came with strong wind from E.S.E. and
thick rainy steering N.W. by compass with all
sail out Mid part better first strong wind from
the E.S.E. and rainy to

Lat 8.35 Long 167.00

Thursday 25th

Came with strong wind from the S.E. and
rainy steering N.W. Mid part better first strong wind
and cloudy to

Lat 11.00 Long 166.48

Friday 26th

First part strong wind from the N.E. and
cloudy steering N.W. Mid part moderate with fresh
rain latter part gentle wind from the S.E. and cloudy
to

Lat about 12.50 Longitude 165

Monday April 27th 1848

First part gentle wind from the S.E. and
cloudy steering S.W. Mid part strong wind
from East latter strong from S.E. and cloudy
to

Tuesday 28th

First part gentle wind from the East and
cloudy steering S.W. with all sail out
Mid part better first light wind and squally
to end

Wednesday 29th

Came with light wind from the S.E. and squally
with rain steering S.W. Mid part better first
light air and fine pleasant weather to

Lat 18.48 Long 157.04

Thursday 30th

First part light wind from the S.E. and
fine pleasant weather steering N.W.
Mid part better first strong wind and some squally
to

Lat 20.41 Long 154.64

Monday May 1st 1848

First part strong wind from the
Eastward and some squally steering N.W. with
all sail out Mid part better first strong
wind from the E.S.E. and fine weather to

Lat 23.77 Long 152.30

Tuesday 2nd

Came with light wind from the E.S.E. and
fine pleasant weather steering S.W. Mid part
light and pleasant the first all sail out
wind from the S.E. to

Lat 25.39 S

Long 151.38 E
