

# Remarks On Board Ship

Saturday May 13<sup>th</sup> 1848

First part light air from the S.E. and  
morning strong N.W. thick foggy  
Mid part strong wind from the W.S.W. and ruggled  
up the top sails latter more moderate make  
all sail standing West at 6. am the States  
Mast in running in set to 11. m. spoke the  
Ship Sagada to Hunt at 10.00 lb whale within  
at 8

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>

First part light air from the West and  
fine pleasant weather strong N.W. three ships in  
sight Middle part light air latter part strong  
wind from the eastward and fine weather strong  
N.W. with all sail out at 9.4. m. got through  
the States took top mast and down sail and  
main royal and fore and mizzen top  
gallant sails three ships in sight at 8

Monday 15<sup>th</sup>

First part strong wind from the S.E. and  
fine weather strong N.W. at 6.30 m. spoke the Ship  
Stat of Sagharbour 33. from 3. m. Whales this season  
Mid part light at 9.4. am and struck a whale  
and Thomas E. Glanville was killed by the  
whale was neck out of the stern of the boat and  
saw the whale must of hit him and stunder  
him for he never moved after he was overboard  
saw him once and before any boat could  
get to him he sunk the whale sunk very heavy  
got him to the ship and he sunk and killed  
all that we had fast to him and we lost the  
whale rather a bad days work at 8

First part light air sun and chert could  
not get fast mid part light latter light air  
sun and lower for whales came in thick came  
on board at 11. m. saw and chert whales spoke  
the Ship Steyner of New Bedford 21. m. and 1000 lbs  
Mid part light air latter of 2 whales this  
season at 8

Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup>

Came with light wind from the Westward  
leading to the South mid part same latter  
first gentle wind from the S.E. and fine weather  
spoke the Ship

Thursday 18<sup>th</sup>

First part light air leading to the South  
at 5 pm spoke the Ship Staton of New Bedford  
so went south whale 400 Harin 3 whales this season  
Mid part moderate latter part strong wind from  
the S.W. leading to the S.E. spoke Island 308  
and bark in sight Lat 38 50

Friday 19<sup>th</sup>

Came with gentle wind from the South  
now ship to the westward mid part light wind  
and thick rain latter part strong wind  
from the S.E. and thick rain two ships in  
sight at 8

Saturday 20<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong gale at 4 pm. took in  
sail strong gale from the West and fresh rain  
Mid part moderate latter part gentle wind from the Westward  
and fine at 8 Lat 38 30 Long 103 00
