

Sunday May 21st 1848

First part light wind from the west at 4 p.m. saw an E. hove for a cow and calf struck the calf got a Boat Stone and lost the whale. Mid & latter part light wind from the Eastward at 11 A.M. saw and chased whale could not get fast to E.

Monday 22nd

First part light wind from the Eastward and fine weather saw and chased several whales plenty of whale in site could not get fast saw two H.P. Mid & latter part light wind saw and chased whale could not get fast to E.

Tuesday 23rd

First part light wind from the Eastward and fine weather saw and chased whale could not get fast mid & latter part light at 5 p.m. saw several cows and calves hove struck the calf and the line parted lost the whale came in thick fog to E.

Wednesday 24th

First part thick fog plenty of whale around at 3 light up saw whale hove struck and killed a small whale at 7 took him to the H.P. Mid part light wind at daylight commenced cutting saw and chased whale at 9 got through cutting thick rain and ship in site Bailing to E.

Thursday 25th

Came with light wind from the E. and rainy at 3 p.m. spoke the H.P. Bonditet of Warren 18 m out south & whale this season Mid & latter part light wind and fine weather stiring to the westward saw nothing to E. Lat 39. 02 Long 136. 07

Friday May 26th 1848

Came with light wind from the N.E. and fine weather stiring to the W. Mid & latter part light wind and fine weather saw several finbacks commenced bailing stiring to the westward to E. Lat 38 30 Long 132. 30

Saturday 27th

First part light wind from the N.E. and fine weather stiring to the westward mid & latter part light wind at 11 A.M. saw a dead whale took him to the H.P.

Sunday 28th

Came with light wind from the Eastward and fine weather commenced cutting at 4 p.m. got through and went to bailing again Mid & latter part light wind and pleasant stiring N.E. at 9 A.M. saw the Island of Haring Id. Lat 25 miles to E. Lat 38 10 Long 130. 15

Monday 29th

Came with light wind from the S.E. and pleasant stiring N.E. with all sail out at 8 A.M. got through bailing Mid & latter part light wind and some thick rain saw and hove for a while going quick to the westward could not get fast shorter galle oil in the tank to E. Lat 39 30 Long 131. 40

Tuesday 30th

Came with light wind from the E. and some thick rain stiring N.E. with all sail out at 8 A.M. and hove for two H.P. Mid & latter part light wind and thick rain saw nothing to E. Lat 40 24

Wednesday 31st

First part gentle wind from the East and thick rain leading to the S.E. Mid & latter part gentle wind from the W. and some foggy saw a Bar E. stiring to the S.W. Lat 41 15 Long 137. 7
