

Wednesday June 22^d 1848

Came with light air and some thick at 1 p.m.
bore and east several whales going to the Eastward
Mid & better part moderate and some thick
at 7 p.m. bore struck and killed a whale at
8 took him to the ship and commenced cutting
the Eng employed in boiling

Thursday 23^d

First part light air and fine weather at 1 p.m.
got through cutting saw several whales going to the
Eastward Mid & better part light wind
and cloudy saw and east a whale employed
in boiling one ship in site boiling 10 Eng

Friday 24^d Lat 40.45 Long 133.08

First part light wind from the S.E. and cloudy
heading to the Eastward Mid & better part light
air and fine weather saw and east whales at 10 cut down
employed in standing down to bed

Saturday 25^d

Came with light air and fine weather at 1 p.m.
bore struck and wound at 5 p.m. bore struck
and got a whale sporting that one boat tried to
first in cut the short work and lost the

Mid better part strong wind from the S.W. and ruggie
saw several whales going quick to the S.W. and employed
in standing down

Sunday 26^d

First part fresh gale from the S.W. and ruggie
in sail saw several whales going quick at 4 p.m.
got through standing 35 lb of oil

Mid & better part moderate and two whales going
quick to the Westward 10 Eng Lat 40.23

Monday June 26^d 1848

First part gentle wind from the Eastward
and fine weather at 4 p.m. saw a dead whale that one that
we killed the 18 hours before at 6 took him to the ship
and had one cut a little and next of for the night
Mid moderate at daylight commenced cutting took the
head at 8 got through 10 Eng Lat 40.16 Long 132.44

Tuesday 27^d

First part light wind from the S.E. and fine weather
employed in boiling saw and east whales one ship in
site Mid & better part light wind and fine pleasant
weather at 7 p.m. saw and bore struck a whale got
the sporting that the line got cut with a 10 lb
and east the whale plenty of whale in site 10 Eng

Wednesday 28^d

First part light wind from the S.W. and fine
pleasant at 3 p.m. struck a whale and one boat
boarded and shot last one in came out and the other
strapped and lost the whale Mid & better
part light wind got through boiling 30 lb of oil
and ship in site and whale

Thursday 29^d

First part light wind and fine pleasant bore and
east could not get fast plenty of whales in site
rather a small lot of whales Mid & better part
light wind and some thick at 10 p.m. bore
and struck and killed a whale got one man lost
one boat lost some to bed

Friday 30^d

First part light air and thick at 1 took the whale
to the ship at 2 commenced cutting at 3 got through
Mid & better part light air and some thick at daylight started
the work saw whales going quick one ship in site 10 Eng Lat 40.14
Long 131.44
