

Saturday July 1st 1848

First part light air and some thick sea
a whale going quickly for the shore part light wind and
raining and sharp lightning. Latter part light wind and
a fine pleasant sun the whale saw a ship got a whale.
Soley Employed in Baiting Lat 40.50 Long 134.08

Sunday 2nd

First part light air from the westward and
fine weather. Mid part gentle wind and fine
Latter part fine at 3 p.m. got through Baiting 28
Lat 40.54 Long 133.40

Monday 3rd

Came with light wind from the Westward
and some thick sea and chast a whale
Mid is better part light air and some thick employed
in Baiting at 11 a.m. hauled for two whales struck
one & 28.5 beats fast

Tuesday 4th

First part light wind at 4 p.m. took the
whale to the shore and cut him in Mid is better part
gentle wind and fine weather employed in Baiting
Soley Lat 40.55 Long 134.31

Wednesday 5th

First part light air and some thick at 3 p.m.
hauled and struck and killed a whale at 7 a.m.
took him to the ship Mid is better part light
and thick rainy at 6 o'clock an got on top in
the fall part the last the hook block let him
by Soley Lat 41.01

Thursday July 6th 1848

Came with light air and thick fogg with
a heavy swell on at 2 o'clock an and cut
the whale in Mid part calm and thick
battered strong wind and thick rainy took in
the four and muzzan top sails employed in
Baiting Soley

Friday 7th

Came with fresh gale from the S.E. and
raining clearest reefs the main top sail employed
in Baiting Mid is better part moderate gale and
thick rainy got through Baiting at 9 a.m. spoke
the ship Cooper of New London Clark 23 went out
2 o'clock weather season Soley

Saturday 8th

First part fresh gale from the S.E. and thick rainy
Mid is better much the same Soley

Sunday 9th

Came with strong gale from the S.E. and
thick rainy ship and offhand talks
Mid is better part much the same Soley

Monday 10th

First part strong gale from the S.E. and
thick rainy Mid part more moderate
Latter part light wind made all sail heaving S.E.
employed in scraping low S.E. paper in site
Soley Lat 41.16 Long 132.47

Tuesday 11th

First part light wind from the S.E. and fine
weather heaving S.E. employed in scraping low S.E. paper
Mort a well of oil in the tanks Mid part moderate
battered strong wind and some thick employed in striking down dows and chast
a whale came on & rain Soley
