

Saturday Aug 2 1848

First part light air from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather saw and chased whales plenty of whales & ships in sight. Mid & latter part gentle wind and fine weather saw two ships cutting S. by E. Lat 45. N. Long 146. 00

Sunday

First part light air and fine pleasant weather saw plenty of humpbacks at 11 A.M. spoke the ship Elyse Adams of Fair Haven (Harting 26 m. out 3000 lbs. 2500 this season. Mid and latter part light air and thick fog

Monday

First part light air and some thick mowing with the E. Adams. Mid & latter part light air and thick fog

Tuesday

First part light air and thick mowing with the E. Adams. Mid & latter part much the same working to the eastward & west

Wednesday

First part calm and thick in company with the E. Adams. Mid & latter part gentle wind from the E. and thick fog heading N. by E.

Thursday

First part gentle wind from the E. and thick fog at 4 P.M. lit up saw plenty of whales landward and chased without success

Mid thick latter part gentle wind and clear at 11 A.M. struck a whale and killed him S. by E. Lat 47. 15 Long 147. 20

Friday Aug 11 1848

First part fresh wind and some rain at 3 took this whale to the ship commenced cutting at 8 got through. Mid & latter part strong gale and rainy started the works the 8 dams in site S. by E.

Saturday 12

First part strong wind and some thick sun and chased whales & ships in sight. Mid part strong wind and fresh rain in the evening. Lat part pleasant with a strong wind started the works at 11 A.M. spoke the ship Hieglitz of Briceport 48 m. out 3000 lbs. new this season. Lat 47. 04 Long 146. 20

Sunday 13

First part calm and clear. Mid much the same got a man out of the Hieglitz. Mid & latter part light air and fine pleasant weather saw and chased whales got through boiling & ships in sight S. by E. Lat 47. 09

Monday 14

First part gentle wind from the South and fine pleasant at 1 P.M. landed struck and the Larboard got stove and ~~had~~ a man killed. Cornebas Rades, near saw him after this. Boat was lost and lost the whale. Mid & latter part gentle wind and fine pleasant weather saw and chased whales several ships in sight saw boiling and some entered S.

Tuesday 15

First part gentle wind and fine pleasant saw plenty of whales chased could not get past. Mid & latter part thick rainy saw and chased whales and a ship got home S. by E.
