First part light wind and thick raining
Mid is better part light wind and thick raining
saw and chased a whale & long & ship in site

Thursday 21st one man in irons

First part light air and fine weather saw and
chased a whale at 7 A.M. spoke ship Calumet of
Huntington south this season & ship Mogul of London
& 200 ship first thick rain later part more clear
spoke ship Hamilton of Liverpool 1400 lbs this
season saw two whales going quick to the north
to 23 plenty of ships in site set 45 58 Long 143 05

Friday 22nd one man in irons

Came with light air from the south and
some misty air different tracks at 5 p.m. spoke
the ship the Thompson of New London 1400 lbs. Mid
part light later part light air and fine weather
to 23 in site & boiling the rest chasing about
to 23 could not get past 23. Lat 45 48

Saturday 23rd one man in irons

First part light air from the south fine weather
saw and chased a whale in site chased several whales
Mid is better part strong wind and rugged sea and
chased a whale at 6 A.M. took in sail & ship in
site to 23

Sunday 24th one man in irons

First part strong gale from the SEW and fine
clear the land in site to the eastward
+ Mid is better part light wind from the ESE and
thick at 6 A.M. spoke the Barque Richmond of Providence
saw 20 m out 2000 lbs saw two whales going quick
to 23

Monday Aug 21st 1848

First part light wind from the SEW and
thick Mid is better part gentle wind and
thick saw and chased for one whale several
ships in site to 23 one man in irons

Tuesday 22nd

Came with light air and thick at 4 p.m.
light up spoke the Panama of Sag Harbor
at 12 o'clock nothing ship the steamer the
of New York for a gale Mid is better part
thick fog saw one whale to 23 one man in
irons

Wednesday 23rd

Came with light air and fog
Mid is better strong wind from the SEW and
several ships in site to 23 set 47 17

Thursday 24th

Came with strong wind and clear Mid is
down south of air at 5 p.m. spoke the ship
agoda first 25 m out 2000 lbs at 8 A.M.
spoke two private ships the Eliza 25 m out
2000 lbs of Harrier Mid is
better part thick fog to 23

Friday 25th

Came with light air and thick raining
Mid is better part strong wind and some misty
saw and chased a whale & ship in site to 23

Saturday 26th

Came with strong wind from the N and some
misty at 2 p.m. chased and chased a whale and
the line anchor and lost the whale at 6 p.m. chased another
and to 23 for a gale set 10 00 m & 1000 lbs got the sun and
chased to 23 ship in site
