

Sunday Aug 27th 1848

Came with gentle wind and cloudy at 3 struck a whale and lost the line and lost the whole fluke of whale in site 15 fathoms in site at 6 P.M. struck some kind of a whale could not make out what it was and did not see and we lost him. Miss D. better part light rain and fine pleasant weather saw and chased whales. 18 fathoms in site. Lat 47. 28

Monday 28th

Came with light air and fine weather at 3 P.M. struck a whale and the line parted and lost the whale. Miss D. better part much the same 20 fathoms in site. Lat 47. 29 Long 149. 31

Tuesday 29th

Came with air and fine weather, lower a chest spoke the North of Newbourn 1800 lbs. Green masted. Miss D. better part light air and misty saw two whales several sail in site. Lat 48. 2

Wednesday 30th

Came with strong wind and misty saw and chased whales. Miss D. better part light air and fine weather at 10 A.M. struck a whale and the throat was got cut and lost the whole 15 fathoms in site. Lat 48. 2

Thursday 31st

Came with light air and fine weather saw and chased whales at 7 A.M. spoke the Carca of Newbourn 1800 lbs. 34 fathoms 3 fathoms

Miss D. better strong wind and clear chest whales saw several ships strike and loose their whale 10 fathoms in site. Lat 48. 2

Friday Sept 1st 1848

Came with strong wind and rugged chest whales at 6 fathoms the ship Parmosa Buzge 16, mout 160 lbs. 1500 lbs. whale also the ship Athab. of St Johns. Miss D. better part strong gale going to SE. Lat 47. 50

Saturday 2nd

Came with strong gale from the N. and misty going to and different tack. Miss D. better part strong wind and thick fog at 1 P.M. lighted up saw two sail. Lat 48. 11 Long 149. 13

Sunday 3rd

Came with light wind from the N. and fine weather heading to the N. saw and a chest whale. Miss D. better part thick fog. Lat 48

Monday 4th

Came with gentle wind at 10 P.M. had a squall from the N.W. with short lightning and heavy thunder fresh rain at 3 P.M. light rain saw 3 ships. Miss D. better strong wind and clear lighted the Island of St. John at 9 A.M. lower and struck a whale and the line got cut both with another in mid. lost the whole three fathoms in site. Lat 48. 2

Tuesday 5th

Came with strong wind and clear at 2 P.M. lower and chest could not get fast came unloose and took in sail to rigging. D. lower D. land in site. Miss D. better part light air and clear saw and chased whales. Lat 48. 2
