

Thursday Sept 28<sup>th</sup> 1848

First part gentle wind from the S.E. and fine weather sent up the four top gallant mast and set up the rigging. Mid. & latter part strong wind from the S.E. bearing E.S.E. Lat 45 48 Long 137 48 E

Friday 29<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong wind from the S.E. and misty bearing E.S. and set the main sail and let another. Mid. & latter part strong wind from the S.E. and fine weather sent up the four top gallant sails. Turning E.S. sent up the four top gallant yard and set the sail S.E. Lat 45 38 Long 136 40

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup>

Came with gentle wind from the N.W. and fine pleasant turning E.S. Mid. & latter part light wind and fine weather at 1 P.M. commenced standing down the side out of the tanks in the main hatch. Lat 44 51

Sunday Oct 1<sup>st</sup>

Came with light wind and cloudy at 4 P.M. strong wind from S. and going got through standing for the day. Mid. part strong gale from the S.E. and rainy. The under cloast reef main top sail. Latter more moderate set the top sails double reef. at 4 P.M. strong wind from the West and fresh rain at 11 quite clear. Lat 45 10 Long 135 52 E

Monday 2<sup>nd</sup>

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and clear. Turning E.S. at 4 P.M. shook out the reefs. Mid. & latter part strong wind from the N.W. and thick rainy at 8 commenced standing in the main hatch. Ship strong E.S. Lat 44

Tuesday Oct 3<sup>rd</sup>

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and thick misty at 4 P.M. got through standing. Turning E.S. & Mid. part strong gale and rugged took in the main top gallant sail. Latter part strong gale and cloudy. Lat 42 50 Long 137 00

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup>

First part strong gale and rugged set the four top gallant sail and four top mast standing sail. Wind from S.W. turning E.S. Mid. part strong and thick. Latter part strong wind and quite clear. set the main top gallant standing sail. Lat 40 55 Long 134 30 E

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong wind from the N.W. and quite clear. Turning E.S. & P.M. compass with all sail set past two sails. Turning to the Eastward. Mid. & latter part light air from the Westward and fine pleasant weather. Turning East. Lat 39 54 Long 137 00 E

Friday 6<sup>th</sup>

Came with light wind and fine pleasant weather. Turning East with all sail set. Mid. & latter part strong wind from the Westward and rainy. Lat 39 50 Long 139 20 E

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong wind from the N.W. and heavy looking weather. Turning East with all sail set. Mid. & latter part light wind from the N.W. and a fine weather. Lat 38 35 Long 138 30 W

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup>

First part strong with thick wind from the S.E. and rugged double reef the top sails. Mid. strong wind and rugged. Lat 38 30 Long 138 10
