Saturday 13th

First part strong wind from S.E. strong E.
Mid part moderate from the East heading S.E.

Sunday Oct 15th 1848

pleasant weather heading S.E. Mid part better part
strong wind and fine heading S.E. with all sail

Calm with gentle wind from the East and
fine pleasant weather heading S.E.
Mid part better part strong wind from the E.S. and
fine weather heading S.E. Lat 25 33 Long 158 50

Tuesday 17th

Calm with strong wind and fine weather heading S.E.
with all sail out Mid part better part light wind
and equally heading from S.E. to S.W. with all sail out
S.E. Lat 23 30 Long 158 30 W

Wednesday 18th

Calm with light wind from the E.S. and fine
pleasant weather heading S.E. with all sail out
Mid part better part light wind and fine weather heading
from S.E. to S.W. at 11 A.M. set the S. Head of Water
X.M. next next being S.W. Lat 22 22 Long 158 34 30 W

Thursday 19th

Calm with light wind from the E.S. and fine
pleasant weather strong E.S. along the shore
Mid part better part gentle wind and fine
weather at 7 A.M. came to anchor in Monalilla
out side the Bar S.E. in 30 fathoms water
