sited Grigam Island during M.S.M. Dist 20 miles
at 10 p.m. went on shore to procure logs &c

Thursday 4th

Came with strong trades and some squally
begin of the west side of grigam there is two English
men and two native in line men and six
ferocious with four children and two to band
has been here for 10 years there is port of logs
and the islanders took of 19 mizing 2 p.m. at
8 p.m. for hundred at 10 p.m. get through land
last forward upon island for road excavating
and the islanders took the Panaman of Sigharbour
road 15 miles out
latter part strong trades and squally at 4 p.m.
at 11 p.m. got over board for to find a place for a
wood and the west side could not land went
and here and went up to the S.W. side

Friday

Friday Dec 1st 1848

Came with strong trades and squally in cutting
wood at sunset went on board with two boats
head of wood and off for the night
Mid p.m. strong trades and squally
boats engaged in mending &c

Saturday 5th

First part strong trades and squally engaged
in mending Mid p.m. with the same &c

Sunday 6th

First part gentle trades at 6 p.m. left off strong west
got to last head of wood and six boats full of
coconuts Mid p.m. is better part gentle trades incoming
at 10 p.m. mid

Monday Dec 7th 1848

First part gentle trades and fine pleasant weather
latter much the same &c Dist 18.35 Long

Tuesday 8th

First part light trades and fine pleasant
weather during mid sails fine back incoming
with the islanders &c Dist 18.40 Long

First part light trades from the eastward and
fine during mid sails in repairing our boats and
painting them &c Dist 18.41 Long 188.20

Came with light trades and pleasant during mid
latter the same &c Dist 18.40 Long 188.21 E

Friday 11th

First part light trades and pleasant but with
the main rigging &c Dist 18.34 Long 188.20

Saturday 12th

Came with light trades and pleasant during mid
latter the same &c Dist 18.35 Long 188.21 E

Sunday 13th

First part gentle trades and pleasant with in with
a stern during night Mid p.m. is better gentle wind and
fine &c Dist 19.09 Long 189.40

Monday 14th

First part strong wind and squally
Mid p.m. took in top gallant sail
latter double reefed the top sail took in the main
sail and the H.S. during night
Dist 19.05 Long 189.04
