

Remarks on Board Ship Liverpool of Liverpool

Monday Jan 30 1845

Came with strong wind from N and some cloudy and two Humphreys Ship on Diffrent tack working to the North. Mid is better part gentle breeze from the North heading N.N.W. Lat 26.05 Long 125.17

Tuesday 31

Came with gentle breeze from the E. and fine pleasant weather heading N.N.W. and all sail out Mid is better part light wind from the S.E. and some cloudy heading S.W. Lat 27.03

Wednesday 1

Came with gentle breeze from the S.E. and cloudy heading N.N.W. Mid is better part strong wind and some rain heading N.W. Lat 28.06

Thursday Feb 1 1845

First part strong wind from the N.W. and rainy heading N.W. at 6 A.M. double reefed top sails took in main sail and gub and were ship to the Eastward Mid is better part strong wind and cloudy at 6 A.M. were ship to the N.W. Lat 29.06 and main sail 28 Lat 28.46

Friday 2

Came with strong wind from the North were ship to the E.S.E. Mid is better part strong wind heading E.S.E. Lat 29.06 Long 125.14 E

Saturday 3

First part strong wind from the North and fine clear weather heading E.S.E. and lifted the fore sail main sail and mizen top sail. Mid part moderate Lat 29.46 Long 125.59

Born in to the Eastern Sea

Sunday Feb 4 1845

Came with light wind from the E.S.E. and fine pleasant weather heading N.W. and all sail out Mid part calm Lat part light wind from East and fine pleasant weather steering N.E. at 7 A.M. saw two whright whals lower without success going quick to the N.E. Lat 30.30

Monday 5

Came with light air from the East and fine pleasant steering N.E. saw a carcass at 2 P.M. saw and lowered for two whals going quick to the S.E. without success Mid part light wind from the North Lat part strong wind from the North at 8 A.M. double reefed the top sail heading E.S.E. Lat 30.50 Long 126.03 E

Tuesday 6

Came with strong wind from the North and rugged heading E.S.E. Mid and better part gentle wind and fine weather at 10 A.M. saw the Alseas Ears rocks Baring North Lat 31.37 Long 128.07

Wednesday 7

First part light wind from the N.W. and fine weather heading N.E. Mid is better part gentle wind and fine weather the haul in at 10 on Diffrent tacks Lat 31.57

Thursday 8

First part gentle wind from the North and fine weather heading N.W. Mid is better part light air and fine weather saw quelforts Island Baring N.W. Lat 40 miles Long
