

Friday Feb 9th 1848

Came with calm wind & the sun
shined till part strong wind from the S.E. and
raining strong S.E. Latter strong at 10 AM. kept
to back in sail at 1 P.M. heavy squally from
the Westward back in the top and heading
South at 11 AM. clear rest the main top sail
set. Blowing heavy more ship to the West.

Sunday 11th

Came with heavy gale from West and rugged
at 10 AM. were ship to the South took in the four
sail. Mid part were moderate better part
moderate more ship strong S.E. made all sail bend
through the straits at 1 P.M. saw Pinnima Solores
Barry S.E. Dist. 30 miles Lat 33.52 Long 128.46 E

Monday 12th

Came with gentle wind from the N.W. and fine
pleasant weather strong E.S.E. and all sail out
Mid part better part light air and fine pleasant
weather got through the straits the land in sight
S.E. saw finbacks Lat 34.46 Long 129.51 E

Tuesday 13th

First part light air from the N.W. and
fine pleasant weather heading N.E.
Mid part light wind from the S.E. and fine
Latter part gentle wind from the South and
cloudy strong N.W. and all sail set Lat 35.25 Long

Wednesday 14th

First part gentle wind from the S.W. and thick
rainy strong N.W. at sunset took in sail double
raft the top sail. Mid part strong breeze
from the Westward strong S.E. at 8 AM. saw finbacks
Solores strong North one top in at 10 AM. Lat 36.04

Thursday Feb 15th 1848

Came with strong wind from the Westward and
cloudy at 2 P.M. spoke the ship Champion of
New Bedford 18th out 1200 while we were strong
at sunset were ship to the South and took in
all sail filled the fore sail the land 15 miles off
Mid part better part strong gale and some snow
heading to the Westward Lat 36.46

Friday 16th

Came with moderate gale from North and
some snow heading to the Westward the land
in sight Mid calm Latter part light wind from
the S.E. and fine pleasant weather running in for
Guilford Island Solores Lat 36.57

Saturday 17th

First part light air from the S.E. and fine
pleasant weather at dark took in sail strong N.W.
Mid part moderate Latter part calm Lat 37.40

Sunday 18th

Came with calm mid part light wind
from the East and fine Latter light wind from
the S.E. and strong strong N.W. Lat 38

Monday 19th

First part light air from the North and very
heading to the Westward
Mid part light air and fine weather
saw and chased two Wright whales the land in sight Lat
about 15 miles Lat
