

Tuesday Sept 20 1848

First part light air and fine weather plenty of finbacks in site. Mid moderate S.W. wind. Saw plenty of fish. Boat 28.

Wednesday 21

Calm with light airs from the S.W. and pleasant yet about 4.15 put out of the port. Boat. The land about 6 miles off. Mid & better gentle wind from the S.W. heading to the East toward S.S. Lat 38.41

Thursday 22

Calm with gentle wind from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather heading East plenty of finbacks in site. Mid part light. Latter gentle wind from the S.E. and thick rainy. Supper. Boat 28.

Friday 23

First part strong wind from the North and thick rainy. Starting at 4 p.m. left two boats in sail at 6 A.M. took in the fore sail heading East. Mid & better strong wind from the S.W. and rugged heading East S.S.

Saturday 24

First part strong wind from the North and rugged. Starting East. Mid & better part strong wind from the S.W. and clear heading to the S.W. saw many land in site S.S. Lat 36.50

Sunday 25

Calm with gentle wind and some thick. Mid & better gentle wind and fine weather saw and heard about two right whales with out success S.S.
