

Wednesday March 28th 1846

Came with light wind from the North and fine pleasant weather at 3 p.m. got through towing at 4 lowered for two whales thick and killed one at 6 p.m. took him to the ship took in sail

Mid & latter part calm at day light commenced cutting at 10 p.m. got through & set Lat 37.55 Long 134.15

Thursday 29th

First part light wind from the West and fine weather lowered twice without success started

the nets & mid & latter part fresh breeze and some thick saw and chased two whales & one employed in boiling Lat 37.57 N

Friday 30th

Came with fresh wind from the SE and some thick Mid & latter part must the same at 10 p.m. got through boiling & set Lat 37.57 East whales

Saturday 31st

Came with strong wind from the Westward and rugga at 10 p.m. lowered thick a whale and the two ships parted with two boats part Mid & latter part strong wind and rugga chased whales & set Lat 38.13 Long 133.28

Sunday April 1st 1846

Came with strong wind from the SE and rugga at 4 p.m. spoke the Midas one whale seen Mid & latter part fresh gale and rain & ships in sight

Monday 2nd

Came with moderate gale and some thick Mid & latter part more moderate chased whales at 11 p.m. spoke the ship Electric of New London Brown 2 whales the season

Tuesday April 3rd 1846

First part strong gale from the Westward took in the four sail Mid & latter part strong gale at 10 A.M. set the four sail 2 ships in sight Lat 37.35

Wednesday 4th

Came with strong gale from North and rugga Mid & latter part light wind and fine clear weather three ships in sight Lat 37.11 Long 134.00

Thursday 5th

First part light wind and fine pleasant weather saw and chased whales Mid and latter part light wind and fine weather at 8 p.m. thick and killed a whale and he sunk saw the Midas & set Lat 37.16

Friday 6th

First part light wind and fine weather saw and chased whales four ships in sight two cutting Mid & latter part light air at 8 p.m. lowered thick and killed a whale at 12 took him to the ship & set

Saturday 7th

Came with calm and clear weather at 1 p.m. commenced cutting at 6 got through and started works Mid and latter part light wind and fine weather at 9 p.m. lowered and killed a whale at 11 p.m. took him to the ship & set

Sunday 8th

Came with light wind and fine weather at 12 commenced cutting at 6 got through lowered and in the time Mid & latter part the same saw three ships boiling & set Lat 37.45 Long 134.32 E
