

Monday April 7th 1848

Calm with light air and fine weather
employed in boiling started 80 lbs in 20 tanks
Mid & better part strong wind and rugged
saw and chased whales 2 & 3

Tuesday 10th

Calm with strong wind from the westward
and rugged saw and chased whales
Mid & better part more moderate 2 & 3
Lat 37.00 Long 135.05

Wednesday 11th

Calm with light wind and some thick
saw and chased whales at 4 p.m. got through
boiling Mid & better part strong gale and
some rain employed in stowing down about off
the main hatch 2 & 3

Thursday 12th

Calm with strong gale and fresh rain
Ship on different tack
Mid & better part strong gale and rain at daylight
no escape note being 2 & 3. List 10 miles were
Ship to the westward out the four sail 2 & 3

Friday 13th

Calm with strong gale from the north
and rugged Mid & better part more moderate
except off stowing 2 & 3 employed in cleaning down
saw fish tanks 2 & 3 Lat 37.20 Long 134.30 E

Saturday 14th

Calm with moderate gale and rugged
stowing up under main top sail and four sail
Mid and better part light wind and fine weather
Leaving to the west and ship in sight
Lat 38.33 Long 134.45

Sunday April 15th 1848

Calm with gentle wind from the N.W. and
fine weather heading to the N.E.
Mid & better part gentle wind and fine weather
saw and chased whales 2 & 3 Lat 37.20 Long 135.24 E

Monday 16th

Calm with light wind from the N.W. and
fine weather and ship in sight
Mid part light wind Lat 37.20 Strong wind from
the S.E. and rainy 2 & 3

Tuesday 17th

Calm with strong wind and rainy at
3 p.m. spoke the ship Margaret & Scudder New Bedford
17 months out 300 whale 100 from Mid & better
part strong wind saw plenty of whales chased
could not get fast 2 & 3 Lat 37.44 Long 135.00 E

Wednesday 18th

Calm with light wind and fine weather
saw and chased whales Mid & better moderate
wind from the north and fine weather 2 & 3
Lat 37.36 Long 136.10

Thursday 19th

Calm with strong wind and rugged
Mid & better part much the same saw several
whales heard struck one and the line for her
and lost the whale 2 & 3 ship in sight
Lat 37.20

Friday 20th

Calm with strong wind and rugged saw and
chased whales Mid & better part the same saw and
chased whales 2 & 3 Lat 38.00
