

Monday May 14th 1846

First part light wind and fine weather at 1 p.m.
spoke the ship *Senae* Howland & whole this season
Mid is better light wind and thick fog 28

Tuesday 15th

First part light wind and some thick
Mid is better part gentle wind and some thick rising
of the water at 9 a.m. spoke the ship *Champion*
of New Bedford nothing this season. Saw *Sanborn* Newborn
a whole this season lower and east side of F

Wednesday 16th First part light wind from the Eastward
and thick foggy rising off to the Eastward
Mid is better strong gale and thick rising

Thursday 17th

First part strong gale from the S.E. and thick
rainy Mid is better the same 28

Friday 18th

First part strong gale from the S.E. and thick
Mid moderate. Latter gentle wind and some
misty steering to the S.W. 28 Lat 40.18 Long 109.20

Saturday 19th

Calm with strong wind from the South and
some thick sun and east whale
Mid is better part light wind and fine weather
saw and east whales spoke the ship *Two Brothers*
of New Bedford nothing 28 Lat 40.45 Long 109.00

Sunday 20th

First part light air and fine weather at 5 bound thick
and killed a whale at 7 took him to the ship Mid is
better moderate at daylight commenced cutting at 10 got
through 2 Dues Lat 40.58

Monday May 21st 1846

Calm with gentle wind and fine weather at 5
spoke the ship *Sansou* of New Bedford & spoke
Korean of 20 Whales Mid is better part moderate
saw *Roman* got a whale 28 Lat 40.55 Long 109.10

Tuesday 22nd

Calm with light air and some thick sun misty
at 5 spoke the *Barge Fortune* of S.B. & whole
this season Mid is better part light air and fine
weather steering to the Westward 28 Lat 41.18 Long 109.20

Wednesday 23rd

Calm with light air and fine weather steering to
the S.W. and ship in sight at 9 a.m. got through
bailing Mid is better part light air and fine weather
saw and east whale 28 Lat 41.08

Thursday 24th

Calm with light air and fine weather saw several
whales distant at one and misty Mid
is better mist the same 28 Lat 41.40 Long 109.07

Friday 25th

Calm with light wind and fine weather at 4 p.m.
lower struck and killed a whale at 5 took him
to the ship Mid is better part light air and fine
weather at 5 commenced cutting at 9 got through
lower east whale and *Barge* in sight 28 Lat 41.45

Saturday 26th

Calm with light air and fine weather saw and
east whales saw a *Barge* & a whale & ship in
sight Mid is better part light air and fine weather
saw and east whales several ships and 28
Lat 41.40
