

Sunday May 31st 1848

Calm with light wind and fine weather
saw and chased whales at 7 started the boats
Mid is better part much the same chased whales
S.E.

Monday 31st

Calm with light wind and some thick saw
blows of whales went on to one and they must have
Mid fast thick better clear and fine weather
saw blows of whales and blows of ships at 10 A.M.
could down S.E. Lat 41.15 Long 131.25

Tuesday 31st

Calm with light air and fine weather saw blows
of whales chased them Mid is better part strong gale and
raining S.E.

Wednesday 31st

Calm with strong gale and thick raining at 6
spoke the ship Mackinaw of N.Y. 13 whales this season
S.E. 1/2 N. 1/2 E. Lat 41.13 Long 131.57

Thursday 31st

Calm with light wind and fine pleasant weather
at 8 got through the land 150 lbs at 5 P.M. spoke the
ship Champion of Edgartown 1 whale this season
saw no whales Mid is better part light wind and
fine weather saw the land and a dead whale Spilt
S.E. Lat 42.12 Long 131.30

Friday June 1st 1848

Calm with light air and some thick dew and
whale Mid is better part light wind and some
thick at 9 A.M. spoke the ship 16 whales this season

Saturday 2nd

First part light wind and fine weather saw several
whales the land in sight about 20 miles off Mid is better
thick S.E.

Sunday June 3rd 1848

Calm with light air and thick fog the land
about 8 miles off Mid is better part much the same
light breeze fell saw the land and one whale
S.E. heading S.W. 1/2 E.

Monday 4th

Calm with light air and thick fog heading to
the S.E. Mid is better much the same S.W.

Tuesday 5th

Calm with light air and thick saw one
whale Mid is better part light air and fine
weather saw two ships Lat 42.13

Wednesday 6th

Calm with light wind and some thick
at 2 P.M. spoke the ship Good Thoubance
of New Bedford 14 whales this season Mid fast
light wind and some thick better strong
wind and clear steering in for the land
at 7 A.M. carried away the fore top sail
yard sent it down and went to fitting an
other the land 15 miles off Lat 42.20 Long 130.50 E

Thursday 7th

Calm with strong wind and rugged saw one
small whale saw the ship Good Thoubance Boat
fast but lost the whale Mid is better part
light air and fine weather saw two whales S.E.

Friday 8th

First part light wind and fine weather Mid is better
strong wind and rugged at 10 A.M. bore for whales
struck one S.E. one ship in its bow and cutting
but still fast
