

Saturday, Aug 18th 1848

Clear with light air and fine weather some thick fogs about 70 lbs of oil. Mia's better light air from S. and some thick & ship in site employed in standing down during the day.

Sunday 19th

Clear with light air from the East and some thick at 5 got through standing about of the fore held. Mia's better part light air from the Eastward and fine weather ship with all sail not heading to the S. E. three Boregs in site saw and chased three whales.

Monday 20th

Clear with light wind from the Eastward and fine weather saw and chased a whale. Mia's better part strong wind and rugged at 8. 1/2 hrs. struck a whale and lost the line and lost the whale. Lt 46 to long 147.08

Tuesday 21st

Clear with strong wind and clear at 2 p.m. spoke the ship Bremen of Sir Stafford 22 m. out 150 lbs sperm of whale. Mia's better part strong wind and rugged at 8. 1/2 hrs. heard and struck a whale and the sun broke lost the whale.

Wednesday 22nd

Clear with strong wind from the Eastward and rugged saw and chased whales. Mia's better with the same at 4 p.m. shot a Comarion via by the name of Challey has been sick all the season.

Thursday 23rd

Clear with strong wind at 1 p.m. heard the man at 4 p.m. spoke the Comarion sailing. Mia's better strong wind and rugged with a thick fog.

Friday Aug 24th 1848

Clear with light air from the S. W. and thick fog. Mia's better part the same employed in setting up. Shocks several holes around the ship, thick & lower.

Saturday 25th

Clear with light air from the S. W. and a thick fog. Mia's better the same saw holes.

Sunday 26th

Clear with light air from the S. W. and thick fog. (A kind of) holes full in with the Comarion and got 32 lbs of water and 5 lbs of soap and 2 coils of twine. Mia's better part the same.

Monday 27th

Clear with calm and thick fog. Mia's better the same.

Tuesday 28th

Clear with calm and thick fog. heard for holes but it was not thick came on board in company with the Comarion. Lt 45 50

Wednesday 29th

Clear with calm and some thick light up heavy falls & ship in site at 4 p.m. heard for a while with out success. Mia's better with a strong breeze from the Eastward. Let the strong breeze from the Eastward & ship in site saw three whales going quick to the Eastward. Lt 46.30 Long 148.10 E

Thursday 30th

Clear with strong breeze from the Eastward and fine weather heading to the S. E. Mia's better part thick saw who was.
