

Saturday Sept 22nd 1848

Came with strong wind from the N.W. and quite clear Mid part strong from the S.W. the strong East with all sail ship started looking into strong from the S.W. and thick but the studding sail at 12 light up
12 men of ship Lat 40.24 Long 157.52 E

Sunday 23rd

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and quite clear steering East with all sail out Mid much the same but part strong wind from the S.W. and rain ship with all sail out at 10 Lat 40.40 Long 171.40 E

Monday 24th

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and clear steering East with all sail out Mid is better part gentle wind from the S.W. and fine weather employed in fitting rigging 12 men of ship the luck of ship Lat 40.37 Long 175.55 E

Tuesday 25th

Came with gentle wind from the S.W. and fine weather ship steering East with all sail out Mid light air from the S.W. and rain the part light wind from the S.W. heading S.W. 12 men of ship

Wednesday 26th

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and rain but the S.W. at 6. A.M. strong gale took in all but the studding sail and fore sail Mid the same heading S.W. the more moderate wind from the S.W. sheet out the reef but a new man to go the studding sail S.W.
Lat 40.16 Long 178.49 E

Thursday 27th

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and some rain steering East Mid is better strong wind from the S.W. and rain S.W.

Friday 28th

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and thick rain steering East Mid and latter part gentle rain from the Eastward ship on different tracks 12 men of ship

Saturday 29th

Came with light wind from the S.W. and thick rain heading East Mid light rain from the Westward latter strong gale and rugged steering East S.W.
Lat 38.50 Long 175.22

Sunday 30th

Came with strong gale from West and rugged at the fore top mast. Heading sail Mid part moderate steering East latter part calm S.W.
12 men of ship Lat 38.50 Long 170.53

Monday 1st

Came with light wind from the S.W. and cloudy steering East with all sail out Mid is better part strong wind from the Westward and rain steering East with all sail out S.W.

Tuesday 2nd

Came with strong wind from the S.W. and specially with rain steering East Mid is better more moderate and fine weather ship with all sail out S.W. Lat 34.55 Long 165.00
12 men of ship

Wednesday 3rd

Came with gentle wind from West and fine weather steering East with all sail out Mid is better part light air and fine clear weather at 10 quarters. Before twelve Peter Mores & Cannacur side with the ferry in his boat 12 men of ship Lat 34.09 Long 163.09

Thursday 4th

Came with light wind from the S.W. and cloudy heading S.W. Mid is better part strong wind from the S.W. and specially with rain heading S.W. at 8. A.M. Berice Peter some very long bases on & came ashore for the 13 men with the same complement
