Thursday Oct 4 1845

Came with strong wind from the E. S. and squally with
rain heading E. S. at 6 took ship to the south took in the 2
sails and reefed fore and main top sail Mid past
strong wind and rain Lett must be same heading to N. E. S. E.
with main top sail out at 12 men of duty

Friday 5th

Came with strong wind from the E. S. and rain with a heavy
swell from the E. S. Mid S better moderate ship heading E. S. E.
with all sail out at 12 men of duty Lat 31.46 Long 156.42

Saturday 6th

Came with light rain from the N. E. and fine pleasant weather
heading E. S. E. with all sail Mid S better part gentle wind
fine fine weather heading E. S. E. Lat 31.07 Long 156.00

Sunday 7th

Came with gentle wind from the E. S. E. and fine pleasant
weather heading E. S. E. Mid S better part the same heading
E. S. E. with all sail out at 12 men of duty Lat 30.14 Long 155.24

Monday 8th

Came with light wind from the East and fine pleasant
weather heading E. S. E. with all sail out Mid S better
part light air and variable ship one different tack with
a thick fog employed in washing ship saw something
in range of the sun we could not see it

Lat 29.01 Long 155.17

Tuesday 9th

First part light air from the E. S. and thick
fog heading to the S. E. Mid S better light air and
thick heading E. S. E. Lat 29.15 Long

Wednesday 10th 11 men of duty

Came with light air from the E. S. E. and thick heading
East Mid S better part the same E

Thursday 11th 1845

First part light air from the South and thick
foggy heading E. S. E. with all sail out at 12
Lat 29.38 Long 157.13

Friday 12th

Came with light air from the South and thick
heading E. S. E. Mid the same Lett part part
from the S. E. took ship to the E. S. E. with all sail out
at 12 men of duty Lat 29.31 Long 156.30

Saturday 13th

Came with fresh wind from the S. E. and some
hazy heading E. S. E. Mid part much the same
Lett strong wind from the South and some squally
tack ship to the Eastward Lat 28.28 Long 157.17

Sunday 14th

Came with strong wind from the South and some
squally heading E. S. E. at 11. Sharp Lightning and
fresh rain cloud up every but the main top sail down
hot down Mid part squally with sharp Lightning
saw the top sail double reefed Lett moderate from
the South and squally set all sail at 12 00

Monday 15th

Came with light air from the N. E. and squally with
rain heading E. S. E. Mid S better part light heading from
E. S. E. with all sail out at 12 Lat 28.30 Long 156.00

Tuesday 16th

Came with gentle wind from the South and fine weather
heading East. S. E. at 6 took to the N. E. S. E. Mid the same
Lett tack to the E. S. E. Lat 28.11
