Fri. August 10th. Moderate gales from S. & Steering S.E.
middle the wind increasing kept off S.E. latter smart
gales at 1 P.M. took in fore top. At the 11th at 8 P.M.
he reef the top sail took in the fore sail & main sail
at 10 took in the fore sail and reefed him and
put him along a heavy gale with a bad
sea on at 11 took in the main &
sail and run under the double reef fore &
sail it raining very heavy from S.W. and
