Wed. Aug. 22nd Moderate breezes from the S.E. by S.
heading on a wind to the east at 7 P.M.
to the S.W. by W. middle and latter
Pleasant weather at 8 A.M. to the
S.E. wind veering to the S.W. and a sail to the
South &c.

Thurs. Aug. 23rd light winds from S.W. steering
S.E. with all sail on at 10 A.M. took a
Breeze from S.W. set the Sails pleasant
weather with a heavy sea &c.
Lat. By obs. 36° 09' Long by Chron. 151° 10' 15' East

Fri. Aug. 24th moderate breezes from S.W. steering
S.E. at 4 P.M. cloudy first light & main sail middle
cloudy wind West latter at 6 A.M. wind veered to
the S.W. took in the Sails at 10 A.M. till 9 A.M.
it lighted up but cloudy saw a right whale &c.
& porpoises & last thing saw a right whale &c.
Lat. By obs. 36° 39' Long by Chron. 151° 50' East

Sat. Aug. 25th light winds from S.W. steering
a wind to the S.E. with all sail at 10 P.M. wind
veering to the S.E. to the S.W. at 10 A.M.
latter strong breezes from S.E. to S. on a
wind to the South & E. a bad swell from S.W. &c.
Lat. by obs. 37° 25' Long by Chron. 152° 00' 00' East

Sun. Aug. 26th Pleasant breezes from S.E. by S. on
a wind to the S.E. with all sail set latter
clear and pleasant &c.
Lat. by obs. 38° 43' Long by Chron. 152° 00' 30' East

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Mon. Aug. 27th Fair at 10 A.M. from S.E. heading
on a wind S.E. middle blowing strong took in
the top sail, sail fifth & main sail and double reef
the top sails at 1 A.M. more moderate set the fore
sail set a reef out the top sails & set the fore
sail at 9 A.M. saw a right whale & a Scapery
saw a ship standing to the S.E. on a wind &c.
Lat. by obs. 38° 54' Long by Chron. 152° 55' East

Tues. Aug. 28th Fair at 10 A.M. from S.E. on a wind
heading S.E. by S. at 4 P.M. took a ship bearing to
the S.W. of what duration I don't know her ensign
was blue & white with a crown in the white at
the center edge of the blue middle took in the top
sail latter strong gales wind S.E. steering
Lat. by obs. 39° 04' Long by Chron. 153° 00' 30' East

Wed. Aug. 29th Fair at 10 A.M. from S.E. steering
S.E. by S. at 4 P.M. double reef the fore & top
sails took in the main top sail fifth & main
sail at 5 P.M. the wind increasing to a gale blast
kept the fore and top sail & reef the fore sail
middle blowing a heavy gale with a heavy sea and
let the ship dance to the wind latter latter more
moderate set a reef out of the fore sail wind S.E. by S.
at 10 A.M. kept off S.W. South &c.
Lat. in 39° 01' Long by Chron. 153° 01' 00' East

Thurs. Aug. 30th Fair at 10 A.M. from S.E. steering
S.E. by S. at 4 P.M. double reef the fore & top
sails at 4 P.M. more moderate saw a right whale sleeping
a very heavy sea on at 4 P.M. let the reef out of the fore
sail fore and main top sail light wind from S.E. at 8 A.M.
main top sail middle blowing wind veered to the S.E. by S.
at the fifth main sail at 8 A.M. it blew and began to
blow at 8 it blew a gale took in fifth & main
sail and double reef the fore and top sail heading S.E.
Lat. by obs. 38° 43' Long by Chron. 153° 43' 45' East
