Sept. 1st. The barometer in the fore and rising with
all sail on wind from the East at 4 P.M. wind
shifted to the N.E. and cleared and commenced blowing
at 4 double reef the top sails took in jib & main sail
latter wind from S. steering S. by E at 10 P.M. wind
made sail at meridian Sept off 5. 40. 30 let 1/2 top

Sun. Sept. 2nd Smart breezes from S. steering S. by E
with all sail on middle & latter pleasant breezes from
S. S. E. to S. S. W. but a heavy swell on S. &c.

Mon. Sept. 3rd Smart breezes from South steering S. by E
under all sail middle blowing the wind increasing to
in the fore top for steering & for S. Gallant sail and
reef the top of sail latter fresh breezes from S. S. W.

This day we find the ship has increased her Lat about

and a bad sea on took in fore & main top sails at 9 A.M.
the wind shifted suddenly to the N. S. W. and moderated
let the double reef fore top sail let a reef out of the main

Thurs. Sept. 6th Smart gales from S. W. to N. S. W.
at 8 P.M. let the main sail at 10 let all sail at mid-
day middle light airs from S. latter squally wind
light & shifting from one point of the compass
to another increased in ships safety &c.

Fri. Sept. 7th Light airs and calm at 2 A.M.
took a light breeze from W. S. W. latter pleasant

weather with a smooth sea steering S. by E

breezes from N. S. W. and smooth and clear weather
steering S. by E at 4 at about a proppos &c.

good clear weather steering S. by E with all sail on
at 8 A.M. the land by obs. was 64. 47. 00 W.
