& squally nothing in sight long by obs. 43. 09. 41

at 6 took in main S.S. sail middle squally latter pleasant

Sat. Sept. 15th Light winds and pleasant with all
sail on steering S.W. at 2 P.M. wind veered to the
W.S.W. and began to blow latter strong breeze at 4 P.M.
Sun. Ministerum Island bearing S.E. Dist 15 pm. Kept the
ship heading for the point at 8 P.M. kept two to the
head of it & sent two boats a shore fishing Saw plenty
Whale the second mate landed and the third
at 10 double reef the top sails hold up the lower part
the fore & main top sail &c. latter 57. 45 & Long by Chron. 77. 50 East

to the west & S. and began a ship breeze steering S.W.

squalls of rain & hail employed in ship duty &c.

Wed. Sept. 18th Pleasant breeze from W.S.W.
with all sail on at 8 P.M. wind veered to the
W.S.W. and squally fired the fore & main sail
at 8 took in fore top in standing sail & main top
sail at 2 P.M. Set the standing sail latter thick wind
veering to the S.W. at 10 took in fore top in standing
sail at 11 the wind increasing to a gale took in
sail and blast reef the fore and main T sails
& reef the fore sail steering S.W. &c. &c.

Thurs. Sept. 19th Heavy gales from W.S.W. under blast
of fore and main top sails & reef fore sail middle wind veered
