Sun Nov. 6th. The barometer in light air from N.E. and
a wind to the S.E. & middle barometer latter at 10 light
air from the N.E. & all sail on the line & light
Latter by obs. 32.15 & long by Chron. 175. 40.00 East

Mon Nov. 7th. The barometer in pleasant breezes from S.E.
& steering by N.E. & by S. wind near middle
wind from N.E. & fore top m. & sail
Latter wind N.E. & very heavy squalls of rain at 9
A.M. it cleared wind latter N.E.
Latter in 32.49 & long by Chron. 177. 40.15 East

Tue Nov. 8th. The barometer in pleasant breeze from
& steering by N.E. & by S. middle strong breezes heading
Latter at 10 P.M. that in thick with heavy rain &
thunder & lightning at 10 it cleared up but all sail
wind from S.W. steering S.E. & S.
Latter by obs. 33.07 & long by Chron. 179. 50.30 West

Wed Nov. 9th. Strong breezes from S.W. steering S.E.
& S.E. by S. middle pleasant latter fine weather at
& 10 P.M. there S.E. & long by obs. at 8 A.M. was 178. 52. 17
Latter by obs. 31.58 & long by Chron. at 8 A.M. was 178. 18. 17

Thu Nov. 10th. Pleasant breezes from West steering S.E.
at 8 P.M. saw the Bay of Rock arising & by 10 P.M. bump
all just about 30 m. & latter light winds from
W.S.W. steering S.E. & S. saw a sail to the S.W. W.
steering to the N. & we fired by a number of obs. by
the sextant the Chron. took about 30 m. to the horizon
of the ship latter 31.59 & long by Chron. 170. 25. West

Fri Nov. 11th. All these 24 hours light winds
from S.W. & S.E. & a wind to the North
on last with all sail in our partner still in
sight saw porpoises black fish &c.
Long by obs. 175. 35. 45 E
Latter by obs. 29.15 & long by Chron. 175. 20. 30 W

on a wind to the North east with all sail on
saw black fish porpoises & latter overcast &c.
Latter by obs. 28.45 & long by Chron. 173. 50. 45 West

Tue Nov. 13th. Light air from the S.E. & heading
to the S.E. & on a wind with all sail on
middle barometer latter light breezes from the S.E. &
heading on a wind to the North &c. On n. On n.
Latter by obs. 28.16 & long by Chron. 173. 45. 30 West

Wed Nov. 14th. Pleasant breezes from S.W. by S. & on
a wind to the North & on a wind from S.W. &
& latter light air and calm &c. &c.
Latter by obs. 27.48 & long by obs. 173. 37 West
On n. On n.

Thu Nov. 15th. The barometer in calm at midnight took
a light breeze from West steering S.W. & all sail
on latter much saw two black fish &c.
Latter by obs. 27.44 & long by Chron. 173. 05. 00 West

Fri Nov. 16th. Light breezes from South steering
N.E. & middle barometer latter light air from South
saw latter as usual
Latter by obs. 26.58 & long by obs. 172. 40 West

Sat Nov. 17th. Light air from the East heading
to the North middle barometer latter light air from
heading & by S. saw a barometer but no whales tops
seen we have been all the way and saw a whale
Latter by obs. 26.18 & long by obs. 172. 18. 45 West

Sun Nov. 18th. All these 24 hours light breezes
from the East and pleasant weather heading
to the North on a wind at 5 P.M. saw breeches &c.
Latter by obs. 25.03 & long by Chron. 172. 06. 15 West
