Mon Jan 14th pleasant trades and fine weather.
at 1 P.M. tacked to the S. & latter wind from N.E.
& on a wind to the S.W. employed butting
out the fore peak for bulk &c. &c.

Tues Jan 15th light trades from the S.E.
on a wind to the S.W. with all sail on
middle beam rather squally saw blackbirds
Lat. by obs. 1. 34. Long 174. 00 West

Wed Jan 16th strong trades from the N.E.
on a wind to the S.W. middle clear heading
to the S.E. rather squally steering S.P. & saw
porpoises employed mending a boat &c. &c.
Lat. by obs. 1. 38. Long by Chron. 173. 31. 30 West

Thurs Jan 17th light trades from S.E. & standing
to the S.W. middle light air from the S. & latter
rather calm saw breaches to the S.E. we fired a
buccant setting to the S.E. &c. &c.
Lat. by obs. 1. 31. Long by Chron. 173. 09. 30 West

Fri Jan 18th light breezes and calms middle
heavy squall of rain rather cloudy in the evening
saw pinbacks Lat. 1. 20. Long 172. 30 West

rather squally and strong winds

Fri Jan 25th light breezes & baffling with heavy rains
at 4 P.M. it cleared wind from S. middle & latter
cloudy and calm saw killers &c.
