Mon 7th light breezes from the S.W. heading
to the South East at 1 P.M. tacked to the S. Middle
Strong wind latter much rain at 1 P.M. tacked
to the S.E. Saw nothing doing
Lat. by Obs. 16.10 Long. by Obs. 171.05.15 West

Tue 8th Mon 8th Strong wind from the S.E. heading
to the S.E. on a wind bent the fore top sail
middle Strong trades breeze kept latter, it was
emplaced fitting new futer? the fore
top mast rigging &c. &c.
Lat. by Obs. 15.54 Long. 171.21 West

Wed 9th light winds and fine weather heading
to the South emplaced fitting rigging saw progress
Lat. by Obs. 14.14 Long. by Obs. 171.25 West

Thurs 10th moderate breezes from the S.E. heading
to the East on a wind middle &
latter Strong breezes at meridian kept of by 2
Lat. by Obs. 13.07 Long. by Obs. 171.45 West

Fri 11th Strong breezes from the South
steering S.E. by E. all sail on latter emplaced
taking up the main rigging &c.
Lat. by Obs. 12.04 Long. in 171.40 West

Sat 12th light breezes from the S.E. steering
S.E. latter light breezes and a smooth sea
Lat. by Obs. 11.55 Long. 171.44 West

Sun 13th light winds and fine weather
Saw Clarence Island bearing S.W. Dist 14 M at
4 P.M. Saw another bearing about E by S from
Clarence Island Dist about 25 M latter Small
and saw latter emplaced repairing main & fore
Lat. by Obs. 10.38 Long. 170.58 West

Ship Log of Navigators Mar 1859
Mon 14th Pleasant breezes and fine weather
heading on a wind from S.E. to East 4 P.M.
Saw an Island bearing S.E. Dist 15 M at 7 past at
about 15 M to the head of it lying in latter about
10.59 I and long about 171.50 West middle and
pleasant breezes on a wind heading S.E. by E
at meridian saw two lee port bearing S
Lat. by Obs. 12.40 Long. 172.00 West

Tue 15th Strong wind heading on a wind
S by W at 5 P.M. kept off W. at midnight kept
two of the S of Perry's latter light rain and
belling steering to the West lat. by Obs. 11.25

Wed 16th light wind & calm of Perry
the current strong strong to the West at
9 A.M. put in two boats for coal and provisions
Came back

Thurs 17th light wind & belling & calm
at 5 P.M. the boats got on board with their tackle
then up and steamed to the South the S.W. point
bearing S.E. Dist 12 M latter Strong breezes light
kept at 5 P.M. tacked to the S.E. Dist 12 M bearing S

Fri 18th light wind & variable weather
to the East with all sail on at 1 P.M. tacked
Strong heading to the S.E. middle kept the
middle heavy squalls took in full and main took
at 5 P.M. backed to the S.E. at the full & put sail
at 11 A.M. let a reef out of the fore top & set the
top of sail & spinnaker

Sat 19th moderate trades and fine weather
on the plain of the Perry working to the East
Saw plenty small fish and birds &c. &c.

Sun 20th fine weather working to the East
of the South of the low land saw birds & fish a plenty
but no whales
