The Mar. 21<sup>st</sup> moderate breezes and fine weather of  
the South Part of Bolaw working to the Eastward  
Saw as much as usual that is birds & small fish

The Mar. 22<sup>nd</sup> moderate breeze & fine weather working  
to the Eastward of the weather part of Bolaw Saw a  
large ship in shore &c.

Sat. Mar. 23<sup>rd</sup> strong breeze from the S.E. &  
working to the Eastward the sail to the N.W.  
standing to the South the end of Bolaw  
bearing W.N.W. 10 p.m. last saw nothing bearing  
S.E. &c.

Sunday March 24<sup>th</sup> light winds and light squalls  
working to the Eastward latter went on shore  
at Toobooloo for trade

Monday March 25<sup>th</sup> pleasant weather better employed in  
getting of water and refreshments &c.

Tuesday Mar. 26<sup>th</sup> light winds and fine weather  
employed in getting of wood & water for the crews  
squalls of wind and rain latter the rain

Wed. 27<sup>th</sup> strong wind and squalls of the South  
Point of Bolaw 1 p.m. sent the boat in with  
a raft for water and one for wood at 8 p.m.  
got on board with the raft of water and took  
it in the aft of rain the South side of the island

Thurs. Mar. 28<sup>th</sup> light winds & calm of the North  
Part of Bolaw Saw nothing

Fri. Mar. 29<sup>th</sup> light winds and calm of the East  
of Bolaw Saw porpoises &c. No Whales

of the weather part of Toobooloo bearing for  
Whales Saw nothing as usual

Sunday Mar. 31<sup>st</sup> light winds and fine  
weather standing to the South at 11 p.m.  
tacked to the S at 4 p.m. tacked to the S.E.  
at 10 p.m. tacked to the S.E. &c.  
Latter by Mr. 15.11 Phang 170. 20 Mar

Mon. Apr. 1<sup>st</sup> light winds and fine weather  
standing to the S.E. &c. Saw nothing  
Latter equally &c.  
Latter in Mr. 15.11 Phang 170. 11 Mar

Tues. Apr. 2<sup>nd</sup> light winds and pleasant  
weather there the day Saw nothing  
Latter in Mr. 14.30 Phang 170. 10 Mar

Wed. Apr. 3<sup>rd</sup> calm all this day employed  
in ship's duty &c.  
Latter in Mr. 15.35 Phang 170. 12 Mar

Thurs. Apr. 4<sup>th</sup> light winds and calm  
Saw nothing as usual &c.  
Latter by Mr. 14.30 Phang 170. 13 Mar

Fri. Apr. 5<sup>th</sup> pleasant breezes and fine  
weather at 1 p.m. kept in Toobooloo at 7 p.m.  
took a Pilot 11 p.m. to anchor in  
Parrapiang in 15 fathoms water  
Boarder Journal omitted

Sat. Apr. 6<sup>th</sup> light winds & squalls  
with showers of rain at 7 p.m. the fore  
sea the wind falling light but not out  
out so we came to anchor this day but  
a Portugee that left here
