left the ship to go in to the bay or harbor of
Nanyangung for a carpenter to work at the
heads the crew used her best heads with in 48
hours from 50 fathoms an hour to 100 ft Water

Thu Jan 30th the light airs and balme at 4 P.M.
put on board the carpenter said that a
North is started latter light airs at 11 A.M.
came to anchor in the harbor filled the sails
& Harbor Journal omitted

Fri Jan 31st light airs and balme latter
at 8 A.M. took the anchor for sea
that in the night raining and the wind
lighting at 11 but not clear from the
land and the Pilot left still raining with
a light air from South steering to the West

Sun Mar 3rd strong winds from S by S
& heavy rain at 6 wind and rain double
recept more moderat went on
there after my Spars at Leana

Wed Mar 4th the strong winds from S.W.
at 5 P.M. took the Spars on board and wore
Ship to the East latter more moderat
at 10 at 5 A.M. spinnaker bore S.W. 6
10 miles

Eastward heavy rains this day saw the main stay
was parted latter by Ob. 12th 11' Long in 164th 30' W

Tue Mar 10th the light winds & Squally weathering
to the Eastward employed in getting up a main
