 Sat Aug 27th light air from the East and
 light squalls up the N. part of Apolow Sound
 Lat. by obs. 13-40 & long by chron. 174-00 W

Sun Aug 28th light from different parts of the
 compass with light showers of rain at 7 A.M.
 left the ship to go on shore of the N.W. of Poul
 Lat. by obs. 13-40 & long by chron. 174-49 West

Mon Aug 29th light wind from all points of
 the compass rain & drizzle and grassy showers
 Lat. by obs. 13-49 South long by chron. 174-40 West

Tue Aug 30th light winds and light squalls
 morning to the East. Went on shore at
 the office for the day 1860
 9999 340

Wed Aug 31st light winds & fine weather
 morning to the East

Thurs Sept 1st light air and squalls of the
 South end of Apolow
 11242

Fri Sept 2nd the foggy day &
 the Pilot came off the ship being from
 South and very foggy at 4 P.M. put the
 ship away for the harbor at 6 have two
 in 6 pathos matter

Sat Sept 3rd the strong trade at 6 A.M. took
 our anchor for sea at 9 but clear
 morning to the East

Sun Sept 4th strong wind at 9 A.M.
 part of the wind up Poul and Sept
 of down the South end for gains
 at noon we kept two with the main
 yard abaft

Ship Load South the Equator 1840
 Sat Sept 11th strong trade on shore trading
 for gains &c

Sat Sept 12th strong winds being off & on
 with the Victory of London no sail

Sun Sept 13th strong trade with the
 Victory of London 17 P.M. out 600 lb

Mon Sept 14th strong trade standing to the
 S.W. on a wind
 Lat. by obs. 14-49 & long by chron. 174-00 W

Tue Sept 15th strong trade standing to the
 S.W. at 6 P.M. talked to the E.S. at 6 A.M.
 back to the South end down main top
 gallant yard & mast sent in by little down
 Lat. by obs. 14-49 & long by chron. 174-00 W

Wed Sept 16th pleasant trade and fine weather
 standing to the South end down full top gallant
 and a mast about the old main sail &
 reed it up. Lat. by obs. 14-49 & long by chron. 174-11 West

Thurs Sept 17th light trades and fine weather
 standing to the South on a wind heading
 from S.W. to S.E. employed repairing sails
 Lat. by obs. 14-11 & long by chron. 174-42 West

Fri Sept 18th light trades & fine weather
 heading from S.W. to S.E. on a wind
 gave a large quantity of the main
 Lat. by obs. 14-44 & long by chron. 174-45 West

Sat Sept 19th light trades on a wind heading
 from S.W. to S.E. with all sail on at 11-30 P.M.
 gave a good whale & point of weather log going
 quick to the S.W. took 10 lbs of blubber
 Lat. by obs. 14-44 & long by chron. 174-44 West
