 Sun. Sept. 20th light winds and fine weather at 30 pm past meridian bore the boats after the whale but could not come up with him at 5 P.M. returned to the ship. Latter light winds with rain at 8 P.M. all cleared up

Mon. Sept. 21st Strong breezes from S.E. at 10 P.M. wind shifted to the S.W. to S.E. and blue strong double reefed the sails took in jib & main sail. Latter strong winds from S.E. heading E on a wind broke out the keel & parts of main

Latt. by obs. 41-11 Long in 174-30 West

Tue. Sept. 22nd Strong winds from S.E. heading to the East middle took in main sail. Latter wind veered to the S.E. and ship to the S.W. employed repairing part of sail. Latt. by obs. 40-57 Long by Chron. 175-07 W

Wed. Sept. 23rd Strong winds from S.E. under double reef main top sail & fore sail heading S.E. by

Latt. by obs. 41-40 Long by Chron. 174-01 W

Thurs. Sept. 24th Strong gales from S.E. on a wind to the S.W. under double reef main top sail & fore sail rather at 1 P.M. saw two whales. At 10 P.M. set the top sails double reef main sail & jib. Latter strong gales on a wind. Latt. by obs. 41-40 Long by acc. 174-40 West

Fri. Sept. 25th Strong trade winds from the S.W. at 4 P.M. saw sperm whale. Latter strong trade wind all sail but of no use. Latt. by obs. 41-40 Long by Chron. 175-09 West

Ship Loan bound North Whaling 1841
 Sat. Sept. 20th light winds & fine weather. Moring 28 P.M. & employed in ship duty. Latt. by obs. 41-07 Long by Chron. 175-19-30 West

Sun. Sept. 21st Pleasant breezes from the S. Moring 2 P.M. Latter wind from S. present points of the compass. Latt. by acc. 45-40 South Long by acc. 175-30 West

Mon. Sept. 22nd 20-20-20-20 S. and cloudy and overcast employed repairing main top sail. Latt. by obs. 46-00 Long by acc. 175-30 West

Tue. Sept. 23rd 20-20-20-20 S. and cloudy to the S. employed repairing main top sail. Latt. by obs. 46-00 Long by acc. 175-30 West

Wed. Sept. 24th 20-20-20-20 S. and cloudy from the S.E. on a wind to the S. at 2 P.M. wind shifted to the S. and S. double reefed the top sail at sunset took in fore & main top sails jib & main sail. Latter strong gales from S. under double reef main top sail & fore sail. Latt. by acc. 47-30 Long by acc. 176-20 West

Thurs. Sept. 25th 20-20-20-20 S. and cloudy from the South giving two whales. Latt. by obs. 48-00 Long by Chron. 174-14-30 W

Fri. Sept. 26th Strong gales from S.E. heading to the East at 1 P.M. it moderated set for main top sail. Latter wind veered to the East (veered) to the S.W. Latter more moderate set all sail heading S.W. Latt. by obs. 49-00 Long by obs. 176-06-30 W

Sat. Sept. 27th Strong breeze from the South Moring to the S. Latter wind from the S.E. on a wind. Latt. by obs. 49-00 Long by acc. 176-44 West
