Begins with a light S. breeze Bark heading N.E. by E. saw several topsails. Spent part of the day heading N.W. Boat put took in N. & L. sail so ends the day.

Begins with a light E. & S. breeze Bark heading N.E. at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark Willis, King, of Watertown at sunset took in sail. Boat put at daylight saw sail & steered N.E. by E. with a light S. breeze two sails in sight so ends this day

Thursday March 27th

Begins with a light air from the S.E. Bark steering N.E. by E. two sails in sight. at sunset took in sail for the night. Boat put at daylight made all sail calm, one sail in sight so ends this 24 hours

The first part of these 24 hours begins with a light breeze from the S.E. Bark heading S. one sail in sight. at sunset took in the light sails. Boat put down single reefed the topsails.
