Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset single reefed the Topsails took in 1/2 of the main sail at daylight set whole Topsails & Courses brook for Deaf spoke the Bark Rose of New Bedford & munched out with 15 lbs oil found home having lost the top sail & main mast by a whale so ends this 24 hours

Friday March 30th
Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset whole Topsails & Courses set sail in light. Boat part set whole Topsails took out for Deaf spoke so ends this 24 hours Longitude 67° 4' West Latitude 24° 36' North

Saturday March 31st
Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset whole Topsails two sails in sight at sunset took in sail Boat part at daylight set all sail so ends this 24 hours Longitude 67° 50' West Latitude 24° 50' North

Sunday April 1st
Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset single reefed Topsails & Courses Boat part set all sail in sight so ends this 24 hours Longitude 68° 20' West Latitude 24° 20' North

Monday April 2^d
Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset all sail in sight at 1 P.M. took in the top & bottom sail and flying jib. at sunset took in sail and tacked. Bark heading S.W. Boat part heavy breeze equalize a English Bark steering S.W. so ends this 24 hours Longitude 68° 00' West Latitude 24° 00' North

Tuesday April 3rd
Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset whole Topsails & Courses set sail in light. Boat part set whole Topsails took out for Deaf spoke so ends this 24 hours Longitude 68° 40' West Latitude 24° 40' North

Wednesday April 4th
Begins with a fresh S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset took in sail & tacked, Bark heading S.W. Boat part made sail and steered off three sails in sight took out for Deaf spoke so ends this 24 hours Longitude 68° 50' West Latitude 24° 50' North

Thursday April 5th
Begins with a fresh S.W. breeze Bark heading S.W. at sunset took in sail. Boat part made sail and steered S.W. employed in setting up head stays two sails in sight so ends this 24 hours Longitude 69° 00' West Latitude 25° 00' North

Friday April 6th
Begins with a moderate S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset took in sail and luffed to the wind & heading S.W. Boat part made sail and kept off S.W. so ends this 24 hours Longitude 69° 20' West Latitude 25° 20' North

Saturday April 7th
Begins with a moderate S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset took in sail and luffed to the wind & heading S.W. Boat part made sail and kept off S.W. so ends this 24 hours Longitude 69° 40' West Latitude 25° 40' North
