

Bark Annamoon lying At Anchor In Fogat

"A.D. 1860"

Friday September 7th

Begins with a strong S Gale at 3 P.M. the Barque Lousin Secor, Fisher, of Edgerton puttee her cables and went a shore and set sail a total wreck, & P.M. more moderate at daylight light breeze, so ends this day.

Saturday September 8th

Begins with a light breeze, took out the oil landed in all 20 bbls. sent on shore 12 casks for fresh water. Lat part fine weather so ends this day.

Sunday September 9th

Begins with fine pleasant weather. Landed watch store on liberty, at sunset all came off. discharging the steward sick so ends this day.

Monday September 10th

Begins with a light E.S. breeze. Landed watch store on liberty, got off 12 casks & 60 bbl fresh water at sunset. Lat watch all came off. Lat part sent on shore four bbl of B.T.O. so ends this day.

Tuesday September 11th

Begins with good weather and a light E.S. breeze. Lat watch store on liberty. Lat watch employed in stowing off the tools & clearing up the ship. Started Beef, Pork & Flour at sunset. Lat watch all came off. Lat part fine weather so ends this day.

Wednesday September 12th

Begins with fine pleasant weather. Lat watch on liberty. Lat watch employed in painting ship at sunset. Lat watch all came on board. Lat part strong breeze so ends this day.

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Thursday September 13th

Begins with a strong E.S. breeze all hands on board employed in painting ship. Lat part strong breeze so ends this day.

Friday September 14th

Begins with a strong E.S. breeze. Landed watch store in the forenoon. Landed in the afternoon at sunset all on board. Lat part light breeze so ends this day.

Saturday September 15th

Begins with a light E.S. breeze took the Landed watch store on the bow. sent up 30 & 10 casks of wine. sent a new Landed watch store on board. Lat part light breeze so ends this day.

Sunday September 16th

Begins with fine pleasant weather and a light N.W. breeze, at 6 A.M. got underway and stood out the N. passage.

Monday Sep 17

Sea account begins with a light breeze from N.W. Bark heading N.E. took the anchor on the bow and stowed the cable below, at sunset the Island of Lousin in sight bearing S distance 10 miles. Took in sail for the night. Lat part made sail. 10 A.M. kept off S.E. so ends this day.

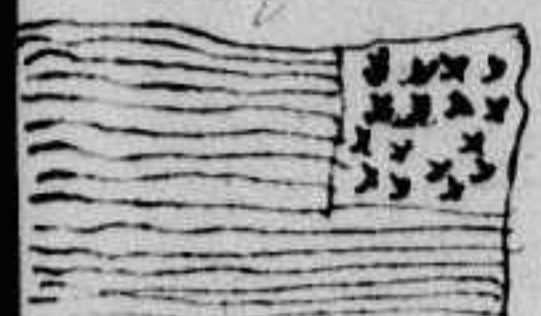
Tuesday September 18th

Begins with a light breeze. Bark steering S.E. Island off Lousin in sight at sunset took in sail. Lat part made sail so ends this day.

Wednesday September 19th

Begins with a light breeze. Bark steering S. the Island of Lousin in sight spoke the Ship Contre. Spangon of New Bedford with 70 bbl sperm, at sunset took in sail and heaved to the wind heading S.E. & took out for B.P. Lat part light N.W. breeze then sent in sight so ends this day.
