

Bark Annawan In The Vicinity Of The Azores 1860

Thursday September 20th

Begins with a calm. Bark heading various ways. The Island of Terceira in sight, distance 10 miles at sunset took in sail. Lat part made sail seen the Island of St. Michael.



So ends these 24 hours. **ST. MICHAEL'S** Latitude 38° 33' North Longitude 23° 17' West

Friday September 21st

Begins with a light Sth breeze. Bark heading N the Island of St. Michael in sight at sunset took in sail. Lat part at part light Sth breeze so ends these 24 hours.

No Ok

Saturday September 22nd

Begins with a light Sth breeze. Bark heading S at sunset took in sail. Lat part made sail steering S. So ends these 24 hours.

No Ok

Sunday September 23rd

Begins with a fresh Sth breeze. Bark steering S the Island of St. Michael in sight at sunset took in sail. Lat part steering Sth so ends this day.

Latitude 37° 47' North.

Monday September 24th

Begins with a strong Sth breeze. Bark steering Sth the Island of St. Michael in sight at sunset took in sail. Lat part made sail strong Sth breeze steering Sth so ends this day.

Latitude 36° 18' North

Tuesday September 25th

Begins with a strong Sth breeze. Bark steering Sth. Lat part strong breeze so ends these 24 hours.

Latitude 35° 35' North

Longitude 23° 37' West

Wednesday September 26th

These 24 hours begins with a strong Sth breeze. Bark steering S at sunset took in sail. Lat part made sail and steered S so ends these 24 hours.

Latitude 32° 47' North

Longitude 22° 33' West

Thursday September 27th

The first part of these 24 hours begins with a moderate Sth breeze. Bark steering S. Lat part light breeze. Lat part calm brock out for water and sail in sight so ends these 24 hours.

Latitude 31° 23' North

Longitude 21° 57' West

Friday September 28th

This 24 hours begins with a light breeze from the N. Bark steering E. Lat part sail in sight. Lat part steered S. Lat part steered S by S. so ends this 24 hours.

Latitude 30° 23' North

Saturday September 29th

The first part of these 24 hours begins with a light Sth breeze. Bark steering S by S. at sunset took in sail. Lat part made sail and brock for by two sails in sight so ends these 24 hours.

Latitude 29° 23' North

Longitude 18° 37' West

Sunday September 30th

The first part of these 24 hours begins with a fresh Sth wind. Bark steering S by S. at sunset took in sail, at 10 P.M. shifted to the wind heading S. Lat part single sail under the top sail. V. Breeze & steered S. at 9 A.M. saw the Island of Palma being 60 miles distant.
