Tuesday November 13th

Begining with a strong breeze & squally from the S.E. Bark heading S.W.
Noon & Lat part the same, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude 3° 41' North
Longitude 21° 49' West

Wednesday Nov 14th

Begining with a strong breeze Bark heading S.W. one sail in sight. Noon
& Lat part the same. Signly see an English Brig steering N.E. so
ends this day. Latitude 2° 32' North
Longitude 22° 43' West.

Thursday Nov 15th

Begining with a strong S.E. wind Bark heading S.W. Noon & Lat
part strong trawls so ends this day. Latitude 00° 58' North
Longitude 23° 31' West

Friday Nov 16th (South Atlantic)

Begining with strong trawls Bark heading S.W. Noon & Lat part
the same so ends this day. Latitude 1° 20' South
Longitude 24° 57' West :::::

Saturday Nov 17th

Begining with a strong S.E. trawls Bark heading S.W. by S. Noon
& Lat strong trawls so ends these 24 hours. Latitude 2° 11' South
Longitude 25° 39' W.

Sunday Nov 18th

Begining with strong S.E. trawls Bark heading S.W. by S. Noon
& Lat part strong breeze so ends this day. Latitude 4° 31' South
Longitude 27° 16' West.

Monday Nov 19th

Begining with strong trawls Bark steering S.W. by S. one
sail in sight Noon & Lat part the same so ends this day
Latitude 6° 54' South
Longitude 28° 29' West

Tuesday Nov 20th

Begining with strong trawls Bark steering S.W. by S. one sail
in sight. Noon part strong breeze. Lat part two sails in sight
so ends this 24 hours. Latitude 9° 19' South
Longitude 30° 17' West

Wednesday November 21st

Begining with strong S.E. trawls Bark steering S.W. Noon & Lat part
fresh breeze knock out for water so ends this day. Lat 11° 23' South
Longitude 31° 43' West

Thursday Nov 22nd

Begining with fresh trawls from the S.E. Bark steering S.W.
Noon & Lat part fresh breeze from the N.E. Bark steering S.W.
so ends this day. Latitude 13° 43' South
Longitude 33° 26' West

Friday Nov 23rd

Begining with fresh trawls from the S.E. Bark steering S.W.
Noon & Lat part strong breeze one sail in sight. Latitude 15° 55' S.
Longitude 34° 37' W.

Saturday Nov 24th (On the Banks of the)

Begining with a strong N.E. wind Bark steering S.W. Lat part at
7 AM saw a large whale going down into the S.W. within
two boats in pursuit and got within two ship length of
him when he went down the first rising was some distance to
the windward but it blowed so the boats could not get to him come
board and took in sail split the jib in a squall so ends this day
Latitude 17° 50' South

Sunday Nov 25th

Begining with thick squally weather with a strong N. wind Bark
heading S.W. under close reefed sails at sunset Lat Boree Crew and
Steward took first watch. Lat part more sail squally one sail in
sight so ends these 24 hours. Latitude 17° 25' South
Longitude 35° 39' West.

Monday Nov 26th

Begining with a strong N.E. wind Bark heading S.W. by S.
one sail in sight, at sunset took in sail Lat part all
topsails & courses so ends these 24 hours.
Latitude 17° 35' South
Longitude 35° 49' West.
