Saturday December 8th

Off 12 hours begins with heavy rain & a strong S.W. wind at 2 P.M. started the work but had to cut down in account of rain at 5 P.M. commenced sailing again. Spent & Lat. put employed in sailing one sail in sight so ends these 24 hours

Longitude 40° 05' West

Sunday Dec 9th

Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading N.E. by E at sunset finished sailing & took in the Fore Topsail Lat. put made sail & stored it to end this day. Latitude 27° 23' South

Monday Dec 10th

(Sail) Begins with a strong S.W. breeze Bark heading N at sunset took in sail. Lat. put blowing a gale from the N.E. so ends these 24 hours

Latitude 23° 27' South
Longitude 41° 37' West

Tuesday Dec 11th

(Sail) Begins with a gale from the N.E. Bark heading to the N.E. under close reef. Spent topsail & Lowsail a 2 P.M. more moderate sail a double reef. Spent topsail Lat. put stowed down the oil in all 1918 galls one sail in sight so ends these 24 hours

Latitude 25° 33' South

Wednesday Dec 12th

Begins with a light S.W. breeze Bark heading S.W. one sail in sight at sunset took in sail. Lat. put strong breeze three sails in sight so ends this day

Latitude 35° 25' South

Thursday Dec 13

Begins with a strong S.W. breeze Bark heading S by E in American Men of War steering N. Lat. put sat close reef. Topsails, Masts & rigging so ends this day

"No OK."



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(Sail) This 24 hours begins with thick rainy weather Bark heading S.W. under close reef. Main topsail & Lowsail Lat. put made sail & stored it to end this day. A gale of wind so this day ends

Saturday Dec 13th

Begins with a gale of wind from the N.E. Bark heading S.E. under a close reef. Main topsail & Lowsail Lat. put made sail & stored it to end this day. A gale of wind so this day ends

Latitude 27° 50' South
Longitude 41° 41' West

Sunday Dec 14th

Begins with a light S.W. breeze Bark heading S.E. at sunset backed heading W & took in sail. Lat. put made sail and stored it to end these 24 hours

Latitude 27° 56' South

Monday Dec 15th

Begins with a light S.W. breeze Bark steering N.E. at sunset took in sail for the night. Lat. put stowed N.E. & employed repairing N.E. sail and 12' top. Sent it to end these 24 hours

"No OK"

Tuesday Dec 16th

Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark steering N.E. two sails in sight at sunset took in sail & stowed it. Lat. put made sail three sails in sight brock out for Reef so ends these 24 hours

Latitude 27° 20' South

Wednesday Dec 17th

Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark steering that sunset took in sail. Lat. put sat reefed topsails & Lowsail so ends these 24 hours

"No OK"

Thursday Dec 18th

Begins with a strong N.E. wind Bark heading N.W. at sunset took in sail. Lat. put made sail with a light S.W. breeze so ends this day

Latitude 26° 13' South
Longitude 44° 27' West
