

Bark Annawan Cruising In The South Atlantic  
A.D. 1860.

Friday December 21<sup>st</sup>

This day began with a light N.W. breeze Bark heading N. at sunset took in sail. Lat. 28° 22' South  
Longitude 44° 07' West

Saturday Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>

Began with a strong E. wind Bark heading E. at sunset took in sail. Lat. 28° 40' South  
Longitude 44° 07' West

Sunday Dec 23<sup>rd</sup>

Began with a light E. wind Bark steering S. went along side of the H. Brig Robert C. Waite 13 days from Providence bound to Rio de Janeiro at sunset took in sail & steered S. one sail in sight so ended these 24 hours

Latitude 28° 38' South

Monday Dec 24<sup>th</sup>

Began with a light N.E. breeze Bark steering S. at sunset took in sail & heaved to the wind heading E. Lat. 28° 02' South  
Longitude 44° 09' West

from 29<sup>th</sup> 1899 I thought I was  
never a hard time before

off at 11-12 AM the last of my life

Wednesday Dec 25<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1860. Henry Christman  
Began with a strong N. wind Bark steering S. at 3 P.M. wind shifted to the E. & a heavy rain squall took in sail to a close reef. Main & fore sails & stay sails heaved to the wind heading S.W. Lat. 28° 18' South  
Longitude 44° 09' West

Thursday Dec 26<sup>th</sup>

Began with a light W. wind Bark heading for the whale at 1 P.M. lowered all three boats in pursuit at 5 P.M. all boats struck stove the S. Boat & tried to cut. S.B. & H. Boats went off fast to the whale leaving the S. Boat crew on the stern boat at sunset H. Boat cut and took them off at 7 P.M. S. Boat parted and came alongside so ended this day Lat. 28° 19' South  
Longitude 44° 09' West
