This 24 hours begins with a heavy S.W. gale Bark heading S.W. thick & rainy on land. Mizen staysail & Gaff topsail set first set reef topsails & courses so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 30 05 South

Thursday Jan 3rd

Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. under reef topsails at sunset took in sail. Lat part blowing a heavy S.W. gale so ends there 24 hours.

(Bar. 30.45) (Therm. 74.0) (Wind S.W.) (Sea S.W.) (Sky B.C.) (Moon 1/2) (Sun 1/2) (Time 10.0) (Lat. 30.0) (Long. 44.0)

Begins with a heavy S.W. gale Bark head to heading S.W. Lat part thick & rainy. Set single reef topsails & wore ship heading N.W. so ends there 24 hours

Begins with a strong S.W. wind with thick rainy weather Bark heading S.W. at sunset took in sail. Thick & rainy so ends there 24 hours

(Bar. 30.45) (Therm. 74.0) (Wind S.W.) (Sea S.W.) (Sky B.C.) (Moon 1/2) (Sun 1/2) (Time 10.0) (Lat. 30.0) (Long. 44.0)

Begins with thick rainy weather & a light S.W. breeze Bark heading S.W. Lat part blowing a gale & raining heavily so ends there 24 hours

(Bar. 30.45) (Therm. 74.0) (Wind S.W.) (Sea S.W.) (Sky B.C.) (Moon 1/2) (Sun 1/2) (Time 10.0) (Lat. 30.0) (Long. 44.0)

Begins with a strong S.W. gale Bark heading S.W. Lat part steering S.W. under double reef main topsails thick & rainy so ends there 24 hours

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Tuesday January 8th

This 24 hours begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark steering S.W. under a close reef main topsails thick & rainy at sunset wore ship heading S.W. Lat part under a close reef main topsails one sail in sight so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 30 55 South
Longitude 44 33 West

Wednesday Jan 9th

Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. under a close reef main topsails. Lat part thick & rainy so ends there 24 hours

Thursday Jan 10th

Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. thick and rainy. Lat part wind hauls into the S.W. Lat part steering S.W. thick & squally so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 31 11 South
Longitude 44 38 West

Friday Jan 11th

Begins with squally S.W. wind Bark heading S.W. at sunset shifted to the wind heading W by N. Lat part strong S.W. wind so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 32 30 South
Longitude 44 35 West

Saturday Jan 12th

Begins with a strong S.W. wind Bark steering N. Lat part at sunset took in sail & shifted to the wind heading W by N. Lat part under reef topsails & courses steering S.W. so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 28 30 South
Longitude 43 35 West

Sunday Jan 13th

Begins with a fresh S.W. wind Bark steering S.W. at sunset shortened sail heading S.W. Lat part strong breeze so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 28 30 South
