A.D. 1861

Thursday July 4th
Begin with a light ESE breeze Bark heading
to several sails in sight. Lat part signalize a
large English Merchant ship steering N.E. so ends
this day
Latitude 37° 30' North
Longitude 41° 55' West

Friday July 5th
Begin with a light breeze Bark steering N.E. course
sails in sight spoke the Bark Conception once
By R. Corrie, Gloucester, of Westport off mouth
out clear so ends this day
Latitude 37° 30' N
Longitude 41° 55' West

Saturday July 6th
Begin with a light N.W. breeze Bark heading N.W.
two sails in sight, at sunset took in seal Lat
part made sail so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 10' North
Longitude 40° 58' West

Sunday July 7th
Begin with a fresh N.E. breeze Bark heading N.E.
spoke the English ship British Flag of Liverpool
go days from Bombay or Liverpool, at sunset took in
Lat so ends this day
Latitude 37° 58' North
Longitude 39° 46' West

Monday July 8th
Begin with a light N.E. breeze Bark steering N.E. Lat
part at 5 P.M. saw sperm whale going slow into the bay
at 7 P.M. in the boats of N.E. & North Boat struck 12 h
took one whale along side & sent the boats to help turn the
other so ends this day
Latitude 37° 50' North
Longitude 39° 48' West

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Tuesday July 9th
Begin with a calm at 9 P.M. took the whale along side &
4 P.M. commenced cutting at sunset Lat part down for the
night, Lat part employed in cutting at 12 h finished
so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 37° 37' North

Wednesday July 10th
Begin with a calm breeze in clearing away the heavy
at sunset commenced bolting N.W. Lat part bolting
so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 03' North

Thursday July 11th
Begin with a light N.W. breeze Bark heading ESE exp-
in bolting N.W. Lat part bolting several sails in sight
so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 03' North

Friday July 12th
Begin with a light N.E. breeze Bark heading N.W.
employed in bolting N.W. Lat part finished bolting Lat
part kept off N. picked up a cask of Brandy so ends
this 24 hours
Latitude 38° 31' North
Longitude 39° 18' West

Saturday July 13th
Begin with a fresh E breeze Bark steering N.W. Lat
part squally employed in stowing down oil so ends
there 24 hours
Latitude 37° 03' North

Sunday July 14th
Begin with a strong S.E. breeze Bark heading S.W.
finished stowing down oil, in all 65 bbls Lat part stow-
ing breeze Bark steering N.W. so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 36° 54' North
Longitude 40° 45' West

Saw a great many whales
Pick up a cask of Brandy
