Sunday July 15th

Begin with a strong S breeze Bark heading N. Lat part made all sail picked up a bl. of Palm Oil so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 37° 52' North
Longitude 30° 22' West

Monday July 16th

Begin with a light S breeze Bark heading N. Lat part made all sail picked up a bl. of Palm Oil so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 28' North
Longitude 30° 28' West

Tuesday July 17th

Begin with a light S breeze Bark heading N. Lat part calm so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 39' N

Wednesday July 18th

Begin with a calm breeze sail in sight Lat part the steering S breeze sail in sight. Latitude 38° 38' North

Thursday July 19th

Begin with a fresh N.W. breeze Bark heading S. Lat part in sight at sunset took in sail Lat part made sail & steering S so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 31' North
Longitude 38° 46' West

Friday July 20th

Begin with a light N.W. breeze Bark heading S. Lat part saw a large sperm whale going slow to the S. W. lowered the boats in pursuit. Boat got up to him he did not faster Lat part lowered for Black Fish took one small one so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 24' North
Longitude 38° 50' West

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Sunday July 21st



Begin with a light breeze Bark heading N. Lat part went on board the Ocean Eagle 18 days from New York bound to Worcester County of Mass. Lat part made sail saw two Whales one of them bottling
Latitude 38° 02' North
Longitude 38° 44' West

Monday July 22nd

Begin with a fresh N.W. breeze Bark heading N. Lat part took in sail Lat part rounded a wreck Humboldt a spell and left her so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 38° 55' N

Tuesday July 23rd

Begin with a strong W. breeze Bark heading N. Lat part took in sail Lat part made sail so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 37° 33' North
Longitude 37° 01' West

Wednesday July 24th

Begin with a strong W. breeze Bark heading S. Lat part spoke the ship Hennington Steamer of New Bedford 45 miles out with 23000 lbs of oil. Lat part heading N.W. so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 37° 21' North
Longitude 37° 17' West

Thursday July 25th

Begin with a strong W. breeze Bark heading S. Lat part took in sail. Lat part saw a large sperm whale & lowered the ship heading S. so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 37° 13' North
Longitude 38° 01' West

Friday July 26th

Begin with a strong N.W. breeze Bark heading West, at sunset took in sail Lat part made sail so ends there 24 hours
Latitude 36° 46' North
Longitude 38° 44' West
