Saturday July 27th
 Begin with a strong N.W. breeze Bark heading N.E. at sunset took in sail. Lat part one sail in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 37° 08' North
 Longitude 38° 48' West

Sunday July 28th
 Begin with a calm at sunset took in sail. Lat part one sail in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 37° 36' North

Monday July 29th
 Begin with a N.E. breeze Bark heading N.E. under close reef Main Top sail & Gaff sail, Lat part sat the Top sail & Gaff sail so ends there 24 hours but 38° 28' N
 Longitude 38° 06' W

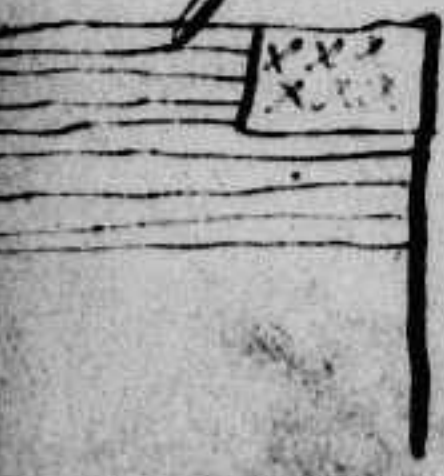
Tuesday July 30th
 Begin with a strong N.E. breeze Bark heading N.E. at sunset took in sail. Lat part sat all sail and steered E. so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 38° 20' North
 Longitude 39° 21' West

Wednesday July 31st
 Begin with a light breeze Bark heading E. S.E. at sunset took in sail. Lat part squally sat reef Top sail & Gaff sail at 12. At turned out the reef one sail in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 38° 46' North
 Longitude 38° 31' West

Thursday August 1st
 Begin with a strong N.W. breeze Bark heading N.E. two sails in sight at 6 P.M. spoke the Bark of Sagadahoc of New Bedford 2 months out from N. E. part spoke two sails in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 39° 17' North

Keep this book on the foremast long as it will hold together

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Friday August 2nd
 Begin with a light N.W. breeze Bark heading N.E. two sails in sight, Lat part under all sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 39° 33' North
 Longitude 38° 06' West

Saturday August 3rd
 Begin with a fresh N.W. breeze Bark heading S. at sunset took in sail. Lat part sat all sail four sails in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 38° 22' North

Sunday August 4th
 Begin with a fresh N.W. breeze Bark heading S.W. lowered for Black Fish and took one at sunset took in sail. Lat part at day light sat all sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 38° 30' North
 Longitude 37° 34' West

Monday August 5th
 Begin with a light N.W. breeze Bark heading N.E. Lat went on board the ship Pacific of 810 tons from New York bound to P. M. at sunset took in sail and wore ship heading S.W. sailed out the Black Fish so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 37° 55' North

Tuesday August 6th
 Begin with a fresh N.W. breeze Bark heading S.W. at sunset took in sail. Lat part under reef Top sail & Gaff sail at 6 A.M. saw a great body of sperm whales going quick in the thrice at 7 A.M. lowered the boats in pursuit at 8 A.M. come on board again, whales going quick to the armoire at 12 M. lowered again so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 38° 28' North
 Longitude 37° 13' West
