Sunday August 18th

Begin with a light N.E. breeze Bark heading E.S.E. at sunset took in sail Boat part took in sail thick & foggy so ends there 24 hours

Monday August 19th

Begin with thick foggy weather Bark heading E.N.E. under a close reef Main Topsail & Foresail one sail in sight. Boat part made sail & steered N.E. so ends there 24 hours

Tuesday August 20th

Begin with a strong N.W. wind Bark heading N. at sunset took in sail Boat part made sail so ends there 24 hours

Wednesday August 21st

Begin with a fresh S.W. breeze Bark heading N.W. at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark May Woodcock of New Bedford 10 months out with 200 bbls No ice & so at part blowing strong with frequent squalls so ends this day

Thursday August 22nd

Begin with thick foggy weather & a strong S.W. wind at sunset took in sail No ice & Boat part blowing a strong N.E. gale with heavy rain so ends there 24 hours

Friday August 23rd

Begin with a heavy S.W. gale Bark laying to under a close reef Main Topsail & Storm sail at sunset were down Fore & Main Sails & Foresail No ice part under hauls in the N.W. Boat part under N.W. at 12 M. saw reef Topsail & Foresail three sails in sight so ends there 24 hours

Don't close the fore & main sails

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Saturday August 24th

Begin with a strong S.W. breeze Bark heading N.W. at 5 P.M. steering S.E. Boat part made sail & steered E so ends there 24 hours

Sunday August 25th

Begin with a light S.W. breeze Bark steering E then sail in sight at sunset took in sail. Boat part calms spoke the Bark Elizabeth Frances Thompson 8 months out with 85 bbls so ends there 24 hours

Lat 40° 42' N

Long 40° 05' W

Monday August 26th

Begin with a calm Bark Elizabeth in company at sunset took in sail & spoke the Bk Eben Dodge Lewis of N.B. 34 months out with 800 bbls so ends there 24 hours

Latitude 40° 35' North

Longitude 38° 59' West

Tuesday August 27th

Begin with a strong S.W. breeze Bark heading S.W. seven whale ships in sight. Boat part strong S.W. wind & heavy spoke the Bk Exeter More Sept 10 months out with 65 bbls so ends this day

Wednesday August 28th

Begin with thick rainy weather and a strong S.W. wind at sunset took in sail Boat part made sail one sail in sight so ends there 24 hours

Latitude 39° 00' North

Thursday August 29th

Begin with a light S.W. breeze Bark steering S.W. & the part seen a Bk. Boat part spoke the ship Elizabeth Parnall of Beverly Mass 70 days from Calcutta bound to Cork so ends this 24 hours
