Hate Cove of Newport, at 9 P.M. wore ship heading N.W.
So ends there 24 hours Latitude 39 12 North

Began with a strong N.W. wind. St. steering S by E
at 4 P.M. heading S. with squally rain. Boat put
more monotonous made sail and steered N.W.
then sail in sight. So ends there 24 hours

Came to anchor at Fogal in Hesperian of water to end this day

From Sept 5th to Sept 16th at Anchor in Fogal, Hesperian

Monday Sept 16th. Sea calm.

Began with a light N.W. breeze. Boat put the same at 7 A.M.
got underway and steered on the passage to end this day

Tuesday Sept 17th

Began with a light breeze from the N.W. at sunset the S end of
Fogal bearing N.W. distance 12 miles. Boat put light E breeze
So ends there 24 hours Lat 37 47 North

Began with a light N.W. breeze. Bark heading N.W. one sail in
sight at sunset the Island of Pico bearing N.W. distance 30 miles
at sunset took in sail. Boat put saw the Island of Seerica

Began with a light N.W. breeze at sunset took in sail, the
Island of Seerica distance 10 miles spoke the St. Sarah
S. by E. 4 miles out 4.0 sperm. Noice & boat put
working up to the land So ends there 24 hours

Began with a fresh E.N.E. breeze. Bark laying off 8 on at the
Island of Pico at sunset boat came on board singled up the
the Hesperian and stood off shore. Boat put off 8 on at Seerica
So ends there 24 hours
