Begin with a strong E breeze Bark steering S by W. Lat part steering S. One sail in sight so ends this day
 Latitude 10° 33' South
 Longitude 51° 04' West

Monday Dec 2nd

Begin with a strong E breeze Bark steering S. W. two sails in sight. Lat part steering S. One sail in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 12° 48' South
 Longitude 52° 14' West

Tuesday Dec 3rd

Begin with a strong E wind steering S. W. two sails in sight. Lat part steering S. One sail in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 14° 56' South
 Longitude 53° 34' West

Wednesday Dec 4th

Begin with a strong E breeze Bark steering S. W. by W. two sails in sight. Lat part steering S. One sail in sight so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 15° 59' South
 Longitude 55° 11' West

Thursday Dec 5th

Begin with a moderate N. E breeze Bark steering S. W. at sunset took in sail Lat part crew watched Lat part sent all sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 17° 36' South
 Longitude 56° 17' West

Friday Dec 6th

Begin with a fresh N. E breeze Bark steering S. W. at sunset took in sail Lat part sent all sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 19° 15' South

Begin with a light E breeze Bark steering S. at sunset took in sail Lat part at daylight sent all sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 20° 32' South

Sunday Dec 8th

Begin with a light E breeze Bark steering S. N. W. Lat part the same so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 20° 59' South

Monday Dec 9th

Begin with a light N. E breeze Bark steering south one sail in sight at sunset took in sail Lat part made sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 21° 04' South

Tuesday Dec 10th

Begin with thick squally weather with a strong S breeze Bark heading S. W. at sunset took in sail Lat part. Once sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 21° 35' South



Wednesday Dec 11th

Begin with a light E breeze Bark heading S. W. spoke the Bark Cornelia Pool of 17 months out with 40 Bbls and Coaling 1 man. Bark Cornelia wholly taken on the 8th will make about 60 Bbls at sunset took in sail heading S so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 21° 07' South

Thursday Dec 12th

Begin with a light E breeze Bark heading S. W. at sunset took in sail Lat part sent all sail so ends there 24 hours
 Latitude 23° 18' South
 Longitude 56° 45' West

Friday Dec 13th

Begin with a fresh N. E breeze Bark heading S. W. one sail in sight spoke the Bark Falcon. Bark of 17 months out with 40 Bbls strong breeze Lat 21° 44' South
