 rainy Latter part fair weather hands
 employed in sailing sails this day

Remarks on board Sunday 17th
 First part light winds Middle
 part calm Latter part light wind
 from S W sea steering S E B E
 sails this day. Lat 35.00 N
 15 miles from N E side of San Miguel

Remarks on board Monday 18th
 First part fine weather from S W
 sea of N E end of San Miguel
 employed in stowing down

Middle part rainy weather from N E Latter
 part squally weather sea marking
 heads of Mary's islands at noon past
 the formigas sailed this day

 First part fresh breezes and clear

 more moderate ship heeling for the
 island sailed this day

 of the island Middle part light winds
 from E Latter part the same sea marking
 heads of the islands sailed this day

 part calm rainy weather Latter part
 fine breezes from S W sea steering
 N E W for Terceira at noon saw a
 sulphur bottom sailed this day

 heeled one whaler in sight the
 first one this voyage at 4 PM
 spook the Bark Ohio Benton from
 Western Ground then Middle and Latter
 part fine winds sailed this day
